CONFERENCE NOTES

- No. 14 Texas Tech and No. 18 West Virginia are in this week's DI Baseball Top 25. In addition, Oklahoma State and Texas are ranked in at least one poll.
- Seven Big 12 teams rank in the top 75 of the April 24 NCAA RPI report. West Virginia, Oklahoma State and Texas rank inside the top-50.
- All nine Big 12 programs rank in the nation's top 75 for average attendance. The Big 12 and the SEC are the only leagues averaging at least 3,000 fans per game.
- Big 12 base stealers have tormented opposing catchers, as West Virginia (91), TCU (91), Kansas State (90), and Oklahoma (88) rank first through fourth among Power 5 teams in total steals. Conference runners steal at an 80.6% clip, which ranks second among all leagues.
- TCU defeated #19 Dallas Baptist 8-5 in a midweek showdown, representing the Big 12's only non-conference ranked matchup.
- WVU's Tevin Tucker (.571, 7 R, 2 SB, 1.327 OPS) was named Big 12 Player of the Week, OU's Carter Campbell (1-0, SV, 8.2 IP, 5 H, 1 ER, 4 K) was named Pitcher of the Week and OSU's Tyler Wulfert (.600, 5 XBH, 7 R, 6 RBI, 1.752 OPS) was Newcomer of the Week.
- Baylor picked up its second top-25 win of the season on Saturday, defeating then-No. 16 Texas Tech 6-4. Cam Caley threw 6.2 innings and allowed a single earned run.
- Kansas' Michael Brooks has 17 hits and 33 total bases since April 16, including a 3-for-3 performance and a 4-for-4 game in that time span. He is hitting .630 during this seven-game hit streak. He donates \$20 of his own money to Lawrence Schools Foundation for each hit he records this season.
- Kansas State has won 13 road games this season, matching the program record, set previously in 2009 and 2013.
- Oklahoma earned its first sweep of Texas since 1998, taking all three games in Austin April 21-22. The Sooner bullpen combined for 11.1 innings pitched and 11 strikeouts, while allowing seven hits and three runs (2.38 ERA) in the series.
- Oklahoma State holds a five-game win streak, tied for the longest active streak in the Big 12 and the second-longest among Power 5 schools. Earlier this season, OSU rattled off a 12-game winning streak.
- TCU's Kole Klecker has seven victories on the season, which leads Division I freshmen and all Big 12 pitchers.
- Texas' Lucas Gordon has six quality starts this season, including each of his last four starts. His 1.84 ERA is on track to be the lowest for a Big 12 starting pitcher since Steven Gingery (Texas Tech) in 2017.
- Texas Tech's Gavin Kash ranks in the top three nationally for hits (69), home runs (20), RBIs (67) and total bases (145). He has the same home run rate (0.48 HR/game) as Texas' Ivan Melendez did during his record-breaking 2022 campaign.
- West Virginia's JJ Wetherholt ranks second in Division I with a .459 batting average. Along with LSU's Dylan Crews, he is attempting to become the first Power 5 player to hit .450+ in a complete season since Florida State's Buster Posey in 2008.
