CONFERENCE NOTES

- Four Big 12 teams are in this week's DI Baseball Top 25 with No. 18 Oklahoma State, No. 19 Texas, No. 21 Texas Tech and No. 25 TCU. It is the third consecutive week with four Big 12 teams ranked. In addition, West Virginia is slotted No. 25 in the weekly NCBWA Poll.
- Seven Big 12 teams rank in the top 100 of the April 10 NCAA RPI report. Texas, Oklahoma State, TCU and West Virginia rank inside the top-50.
- All nine Big 12 programs rank in the nation's top-100 for average attendance, with seven inside the top-50. The Big 12 and the SEC are the only leagues with every school averaging at least 1,000 fans per game.
- Texas Tech's Tim Tadlock won his 400th career game on April 8. He is the second coach to win 400-or-more games at Texas Tech.
- The midweek slate is highlighted by a ranked two-game series between No. 21 Texas Tech and No. 8 Stanford. In addition, Kansas hosts Texas Southern in the Buck O'Neil Classic at Legends Field in Kansas City, Kansas, honoring the Baseball Hall of Famer and Negro League pioneer.
- Home teams have dominated in Big 12 play, with 13 of the 15 series being won by the home team. West Virginia has been involved in the two other series, taking 2-of-3 at K-State but dropping 2-of-3 at home to Kansas.
- TCU's Anthony Silva (.615, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 3 SB, 1.765 OPS) was named Big 12 Player of the Week, K-State's Tyson Neighbors (SV, 3.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 8 K) and WVU's Robby Porco (W, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 12 K) were named Co-Pitchers of the Week plus KU's Cole Elvis (.353, 3 HR, 4 R, 6 RBI, 1.358 OPS) was Newcomer of the Week.
- Baylor's Kolby Branch was 6-for-10 with five RBIs, five runs scored and three extra-base hits in the Bears' series win against Oklahoma (Apr. 6-8).
- At 5-4, Kansas has its best start in Big 12 play since the 2014 season. The series win over then-No. 24 West Virginia (Apr. 7-9) is KU's first over a ranked opponent since 2018.
- Kansas State has drawn a nation-leading 259 free passes this season. Four Wildcats (Brady Day, Brendan Jones, Dom Hughes and Cash Rugely) rank in Division I's top 100 in both walks and walks per game.
- Oklahoma's Bryce Madron leads the nation, having drawn 41 bases on balls. He boasts a team-high .472 on-base percentage.
- Oklahoma State ranks eighth nationally, and is fourth among Power 5 squads, with 61 home runs this season. Roc Riggio leads OSU with 10 round-trippers.
- TCU had a seven-run eighth inning to break a 5-5 tie and defeat then-No. 16 Oklahoma State 12-5 (Apr. 8).
- Texas' Dylan Campbell hit .462 (6-for-13) including a three-hit performance on April 9 as the Longhorns took a series from Kansas State.
- Texas Tech's Zac Vooletich went 4-for-6 with a home run, double and three RBIs in the doubleheader against NDSU (Apr. 8) posting a 2.083 OPS in the two games.
- West Virginia's JJ Wetherholt leads Division I second basemen with a .448 batting average. He has seven home runs and 25 stolen bases on the year.
