CONFERENCE NOTES

- No. 6 West Virginia and No. 25 Oklahoma State are in this week's DI Baseball Top 25. In addition, Kansas State and Texas Tech are ranked in at least one poll.
- The field of eight is set for the Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship. Kansas, Kansas State, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas, Texas Tech and West Virginia compete May 24-28 at Globe Life Field.
- West Virginia can clinch a share of its first Big 12 title with one win against Texas or an Oklahoma State loss. OSU is the only other team that can win the title outright, while Kansas State and Texas can still clinch shares.
- The Big 12 has 78% of its membership ranked No. 52-or-better in the May 15 RPI report. West Virginia and Oklahoma State are inside the top 25.
- All nine Big 12 programs rank in the nation's top 80 for average attendance. The Big 12 and the SEC are the only leagues averaging at least 3,000 fans per game.
- OSU's Chase Adkison (.636, 3B, HR, 8 RBI, 1.805 OPS) and WVU's JJ Wetherholt (.500, 2 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI, 1.579 OPS) were named Big 12 Co-Players of the Week, TCU's Kole Klecker (1-0, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 2 K) was named Pitcher of the Week and OSU's Nolan Schubart (.500, 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 1.467 OPS) was named Newcomer of the Week.
- Baylor freshman Kolby Branch leads the team with a .323 average, 16 doubles, five home runs and a .918 OPS.
- Kansas has three players with double-digit home runs for the first time since 2004. Cole Elvis (12), Jason Reeder (11) and Chase Jans (10) have all reached that plateau.
- Kansas State has a school-record 14 road wins. The Wildcats have their most wins in Big 12 play since the 2013 season.
- Oklahoma scored 32 runs in its three-game sweep of Gonzaga (May 12-14). The Sooners hit .376 in the series.
- Oklahoma State set a season-high for a Big 12 game with 18 hits and matched a season-high with 19 runs in the May 13 win over Kansas State.
- TCU's Brayden Taylor has 42 career home runs (17 in 2023), and is two round-trippers short of Royce Huffman's (1996-99) program record.
- Texas' Dylan Campbell has hit safely in a school-record 30 consecutive games. He has raised his average by over .100 during the streak, and is now at .331.
- Texas Tech's Brandon Beckel struck out a career-high seven and pitched a career-long four innings in relief in the Red Raiders' series-opener against West Virginia (May 12).
- West Virginia's JJ Wetherholt is leading the DI batting title race at .466, and is looking to become the first Big 12 player to win the title since 1999. He is aiming to become the first Power 5 player to hit over .450 in a season since Florida State's Buster Posey (.463) in 2008.
