On how the team persevered...

"It was a heck of a battle. I mean, it starts off with them grabbing the momentum coming out of the weather delay and all of those things, so I think we battled back. I'm really proud of the way we found a way to fight through"

On the performance of Jason Bean...

"So happy for Jason. I always say it's so much with mixed emotions that I have without Jalon playing, but there's there's a part of me that actually has this extra feelings of pulling for Jason for everything that he's given. This program, the unselfishness. You know, again, for him fighting through the ups and downs, and you know and I'm so proud of him and proud of this football team."

On how the defense bounced back...

"We struggled there for a bit on some fits, made some adjustments, and tried to tell them some things that we had to get done a little bit better. I thought the staff did a nice job getting that to the guys, but most importantly, they went out and made some plays. You know, as we're talking about different ones, Kenny Logan's showing up at the line of scrimmage, putting his face on people where he's making physical stops. Taiwan Berryhill is blitzing and sticks his foot in the ground and comes back and chases the quarterback down just some small things there. That really, really helped us, and, again, holistically, it's, it's a big win for us and a great job by that defense."

On the overall message...

"Well, I appreciate it but this ain't about my career. This is about a program. This is about a team and building a program, doing it the right way, stacking wins, helping us in recruiting everything, helping us in fundraising. Whatever it is that it takes, you know, I'll be okay. It's about a staff that works hard, administration that supports us, all the things that you want that you need to for a program like ours to be able to compete and beat a team like Oklahoma."
