TIPOFF

- Kansas women's basketball looks to bounce back from its first defeat of the 2023-24 season when the Jayhawks head to Municipal Auditorium in Kansas City, Missouri, to face Kansas City on Saturday, Nov. 18.
- Tipoff is set for 3:30 p.m. CT and the game will be streamed on KUAthletics.com. Audio on the broadcast will be provided by the Jayhawk Radio Network from Learfield, with Steven Davis calling the action.
- The Jayhawks head to Kansas City with a 1-1 record on the year following a 91-85 defeat at Penn State on Nov. 13. Kansas had four players score in double figures, led by Holly Kersgieter with 24 points, while Taiyanna Jackson added 18 points and eight rebounds.
- This is KU's second of four consecutive games away from Allen Fieldhouse and the first of three straight which will be played at a neutral site. Kansas has won two straight and eight of its last nine games against Kansas City, with each of those games being played in Lawrence.
- Kansas City is 1-2 on the year and coming off back-to-back two-point losses at UTEP and against Utah State, both of which came by the exact same score of 62-60. The Roos, who were picked to finish ninth in Summit League this season, opened the year with a 73-66 win over Bradley.
- The Jayhawks were picked to finish third in the Big 12 Conference during the 2023-24 season. Kansas earned a top-three conference projection for the fourth time in league history, and the first since being picked second prior to the 2009-10 season.
- Brandon Schneider is in his ninth season leading the Jayhawks. The 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year has guided Kansas to back-to-back 20-win seasons and postseason appearances. Schneider, who recorded his 500th career win last season, has a career record of 509-275.

KANSAS NOTES

- Kansas has been led by its four returning starters this season, while each player in the starting five is scoring in double figures.
- Unanimous Preseason All-Big selection Taiyanna Jackson is averaging 16.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.5 blocked shots per game while shooting 65.2% (15-23) from the field. On Nov. 14, Jackson was named to the Wooden Award Watch List, her third preseason watch list. She's also been recognized by the Naismith Award and the Lisa Leslie Award.
- Holly Kersgieter led the Jayhawks with 24 points at Penn State, which gives her exactly 1,600 career points. Kersgieter, who is 10th in career scoring at Kansas, is currently KU's leading scorer at 20.5 points per game.
- Wyvette Mayberry is third on the team in scoring, averaging 13.0 points per game while hitting 5-of-9 (55.6%) three-pointers this season. Mayberry surpassed the 1,000-point milestone for her career in KU's season-opening victory over Northwestern State on Nov. 8.
- Zakiyah Franklin totaled 17 points at Penn State and she's averaging 11.5 points and 4.0 assists per game this season. Franklin became KU's all-time leader in minutes played during the season opener against Northwestern State, then surpassed 4,000 career minutes during the game at Penn State.
- Kansas freshman S'Mya Nichols set a new career-high with 14 points against Penn State. She is averaging 10.5 points, 3.0 assists and 2.5 rebounds per game.

UP NEXT

• Kansas heads to George Town, Cayman Islands next week for the Cayman Islands Classic, where the Jayhawks will meet a pair of highly ranked non-conference opponents. KU will play No. 9 Virginia Tech on Nov. 24, before facing No. 8 UConn on Nov. 25.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

- · Kansas returned four starters from 2022-23, including Preseason All-Big 12 selections Taiyanna Jackson, Zakivah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter. Jackson earned a unanimous selection, while Franklin was on the preseason team and Kersgieter received honorable mention.
- Kansas entered the 2023-24 season after claiming THE NEWCOMERS the WNIT Championship with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse on April 1. Jackson was named the WNIT Most Valuable Player after posting 17 points and 21 rebounds in the finale. Jackson topped the all-time tournament record for most rebounds (78) and most offensive rebounds (33) in a postseason WNIT.

- · Hailing from East Chicago, Indiana, Taiyanna Jackson is in her third season at Kansas and she in guard Laia Conesa, center Paris Gaines and has broken the single-season blocks record in both of her previous seasons. She burst on to the scene with 95 blocks in her first season at KU, then surpassed that record with 109 blocks in 2022-23. Jackson entered her super-senior season with 204 blocked shots to her credit, needing 66 to break KU's career record. She opened her super-senior season with five blocks against Northwestern
- Player of the Year Watch List, which recognizes best overall player in NCAA Division I women's basketball. She is one of 50 selections to the list.
- Entering the 2023-24 season, Jackson earned a unanimous selection on the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. She has earned this recognition after being named to the All-Big 12 First Team and the All-Big 12 Defensive Team, both unanimously, and a twotime Big 12 Player of the Week in 2022-23.
- Jackson is also one of 20 players named to the Lisa Leslie Preseason Award Watch List. Jackson finished the 2022-23 campaign posting 23 doubledoubles, the third-most in a single-season in Kansas history, and ranked second in KU history with a field goal percentage of 66.1, which ranked season, led by Alayna Contreras with 14.5 points fourth nationally.

PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

- Zakiyah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson have both been named to preseason award watch lists heading into the 2023-24 season.
- Franklin is one of 20 players selected to the Nancy Liberman Preseason Award Watch List, which recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Franklin led the Jayhawks in scoring with 15.7 points per game last season and has started 117 games in her career at Kansas, scoring 1,559 career points.
- Jackson earned a spot on two watch lists, being recognized as one of 20 candidates for the Lisa Leslie Award, which recognizes the best center in history. college basketball, and one of 50 for the Naismith Player of the Year Award.

EUROPEAN TRIP IN REVIEW

- This summer, the Kansas women's basketball team took an informational and educational European trip, spanning from Aug. 6-16. The team visited Rome and Sorrento, Italy and Athens, Greece.
- · While in Rome, the Jayhawks visited the Colosseum, Spanish Steps, Vatican City and Pompeii, some of the most historic venues in all of Europe. The trip concluded in Athens, Greece. The team visited the Acropolis, the Parthenon and the Olympic Museums.

• The team did see the hardwood, as they faced off against two National Select Teams, Italian Select and Greek Select. The Jayhawks won both contests by a combined score of 207-110. Newcomer S'Mya Nichols led the way offensively in both games, scoring 42 points combined.

- · KU welcomed six newcomers to the squad, highlighted by five-star guard S'Mya Nichols out of Overland Park, Kansas.
- The most experienced of the group is Alabama transfer Rvan Cobbins as she enters her fifth season of college basketball. Along with Nichols and Cobbins, Skyler Gill transferred from North Alabama where she was a two-time ASUN Conference Player of the Year and All-ASUN Second Team Selection.
- The squad also welcomes three more freshmen guard McKenzie Smith. Conesa hails from Barcelona, Spain, where she competed in the FIBA U16 European Challengers, FIBA U17 Women's Basketball World Cup, as she helped Spain to a runner-up finish.

BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL / AWARDS

- Kansas was picked to finish third in the annual Preseason Big 12 Poll, voted on by the league's Jackson was recently named to the Naismith head coaches. This is the fourth time in program history the Jayhawks have earned a top-three projection and first since being picked second prior to the 2009-10 season.

Brandon Schneider is in his ninth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider has led the Jayhawks to the postseason in each of the past two seasons. The 2022-23 season saw Kansas finish with a 25-11 record after winning the WNIT with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks played all six of its WNIT games at home and averaged 3,481 per game for the season, marking a 122 percent increase in home attendance from the 2021-22 season.

KU finished with 25 wins for just the sixth time in program history, and the first since 1996-97. The Jayhawks have now won 20 or more games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2012 and 2013. For his efforts, Schneider was named the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) Women's Four-Year College Coach of the Year in 2023, his third time earning the honor after also claiming in 2006 and 2010 as the head coach at Emporia State. During the 2022-23 season, Schneider became the 33rd active Division I coach to reach 500 career victories, picking up win No. 500 on Feb. 26, 2023, with a 66-57 win over Oklahoma State

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Javhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider guided Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached 11 players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and two named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with six Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 37 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in both 2022 and 2023. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA

in the 2021 fall semester

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches.

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006 and 2010, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob. was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition. Schneider's brother. Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
