TIPOFF

• The Kansas Jayhawks will spend Thanksgiving weekend at the Cayman Islands Classic, where KU will face Top 10 opponents in consecutive days, matching up against No. 9 Virginia Tech and No. 6 UConn.

• Kansas will meet Virginia Tech at 4 p.m. CT on Friday, Nov. 24, before taking on UConn at 6:30 p.m. CT on Saturday, Nov. 25. Both games will be played at John Gray Gymnasium in George Town, Cayman Islands.

• Both games will be streamed by FloSports, while the audio broadcast will be provided by the Jayhawk Radio Network from Learfield, with Steven Davis calling the action.

• Kansas heads to the Cayman Islands with a 2-1 record following its 70-61 victory over Kansas City on Saturday, Nov. 18 at Municipal Auditorium.

• Four starters scored in double figures against Kansas City, led by S'Mya Nichols with 17 points while Taiyanna Jackson recorded her second double-double in three games with 12 points and 12 rebounds.

• Kansas is in the midst of a four-game stretch of road or neutral games, which started with a 91-85 defeat at Penn State on Nov. 13. The Jayhawks have played just once at Allen Fieldhouse this season, defeating Northwestern State 88-46 on Nov. 8 to open the season.

• Virginia Tech is 3-1 on the season and ranked No. 9 in both national polls this week. The Hokies lone loss was an 80-76 defeat against No. 3 Iowa, while they have victories over High Point, Houston Christian and UNC Greensboro. A Final Four team last season, VT is led by All-America center Elizabeth Kitley, who averages 24.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per game.

• UConn is 3-1 on the season and ranked No. 6 in

the AP Top 25 poll following victories over No. 20 Maryland and Minnesota last week. The Huskies are led by All-America forward Aaliyah Edwards, who averages 18.0 points per game, and 2021 Wooden Award winner Paige Bueckers, who's posting 17.8 points per contest.

KANSAS NOTES

• Four Jayhawks are averaging double figures in scoring, while all five starters are at 9.0 points per game through the first three outings of the season.

• Holly Kersgieter is leading the way, scoring 18.7 points per game while shooting 60.0% (21-35) from the field and 55.0% (11-20) from three-point range. Kersgieter is 10th in career scoring at Kansas with 1,615 points and third in three-pointers with 219 in her career.

• Unanimous Preseason All-Big selection Taiyanna Jackson is averaging 14.7 points, 10.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocked shots per game while shooting 58.3% (21-36) from the field. On Nov. 14, Jackson was named to the Wooden Award Watch List, her third preseason watch list. She's also been recognized by the Naismith Award and the Lisa Leslie Award.

• Kansas freshman S'Mya Nichols has set a new career-high in scoring in each of the last two games, first with 14 points at Penn State, followed by 17 against Kansas City. Nichols is now averaging 12.7 points per game for the year.

UP NEXT

• Kansas returns home to Allen Fieldhouse on Thursday, Nov. 30, to host Southeastern Louisiana in non-conference action. That game is set to tip off at 6:30 p.m. and be televised on ESPN+.

Taiyanna Jackson is in her third and final season at Kansas, where she is ranked second on the all-time Kansas blocks list. Jackson has broken the single-season blocks record in each of her first two seasons at KU and is fifth in career double-doubles, recording her 28th versus Kansas City.



Zakiyah Franklin became the program leader in career minutes against Northwestern State on Nov. 8. She has played 4,048 minutes in 124 career games. Franklin is No. 12 on KU's career scoring list and eighth in career free throws made, while ranking fifth with 438 career assists.



Holly Kersgieter moved into the Top 10 on KU's career scoring list after scoring 17 points against Northwestern State on Nov. 8. She is also third in three-point field goals made, ninth in free throws made and just outside the top-10 for games played. Kersgieter now has points 1,615 for her career.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

• Kansas returned four starters from 2022-23, including Preseason All-Big 12 selections Taiyanna Jackson, Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter. Jackson earned a unanimous selection, while Franklin was on the preseason team and Kersgieter received honorable mention.

• Kansas entered the 2023-24 season after claiming the WNIT Championship with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse on April 1. Jackson was named the WNIT Most Valuable Player after posting 17 points and 21 rebounds in the finale. Jackson topped the all-time tournament record for most rebounds (78) and most offensive rebounds (33) in a postseason WNIT.

TWIN

• Hailing from East Chicago, Indiana, Taiyanna Jackson is in her third season at Kansas and she has broken the single-season blocks record in both of her previous seasons. She burst on to the scene with 95 blocks in her first season at KU, then surpassed that record with 109 blocks in 2022-23. Jackson entered her super-senior season with 204 blocked shots to her credit, needing 66 to break KU's career record. She opened her super-senior season with five blocks against Northwestern State.

• Jackson was recently named to the Naismith Player of the Year Watch List, which recognizes the best overall player in NCAA Division I women's basketball. She is one of 50 selections to the list.

• Entering the 2023-24 season, Jackson earned a unanimous selection on the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. She has earned this recognition after being named to the All-Big 12 First Team and the All-Big 12 Defensive Team, both unanimously, and a two-time Big 12 Player of the Week in 2022-23.

• Jackson is also one of 20 players named to the Lisa Leslie Preseason Award Watch List. Jackson finished the 2022-23 campaign posting 23 double-doubles, the third-most in a single-season in Kansas history, and ranked second in KU history with a field goal percentage of 66.1, which ranked fourth nationally.

PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

• Zakiyah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson have both been named to preseason award watch lists heading into the 2023-24 season.

• Franklin is one of 20 players selected to the Nancy Liberman Preseason Award Watch List, which recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Franklin led the Jayhawks in scoring with 15.7 points per game last season and has started 117 games in her career at Kansas, scoring 1,559 career points.

• Jackson earned a spot on two watch lists, being recognized as one of 20 candidates for the Lisa Leslie Award, which recognizes the best center in college basketball, and one of 50 for the Naismith Player of the Year Award.

EUROPEAN TRIP IN REVIEW

• This summer, the Kansas women's basketball team took an informational and educational European trip, spanning from Aug. 6-16. The team visited Rome and Sorrento, Italy and Athens, Greece.

• While in Rome, the Jayhawks visited the Colosseum, Spanish Steps, Vatican City and Pompeii, some of the most historic venues in all of Europe. The trip concluded in Athens, Greece. The team visited the Acropolis, the Parthenon and the Olympic Museums.

• The team did see the hardwood, as they faced off against two National Select Teams, Italian Select and Greek Select. The Jayhawks won both contests by a combined score of 207-110. Newcomer S'Mya Nichols led the way offensively in both games, scoring 42 points combined.

THE NEWCOMERS

• KU welcomed six newcomers to the squad, highlighted by five-star guard S'Mya Nichols out of Overland Park, Kansas.

• The most experienced of the group is Alabama transfer Ryan Cobbins as she enters her fifth season of college basketball. Along with Nichols and Cobbins, Skyler Gill transferred from North Alabama where she was a two-time ASUN Conference Player of the Year and All-ASUN Second Team Selection.

• The squad also welcomes three more freshmen in guard Laia Conesa, center Paris Gaines and guard McKenzie Smith. Conesa hails from Barcelona, Spain, where she competed in the FIBA U16 European Challengers, FIBA U17 Women's Basketball World Cup, as she helped Spain to a runner-up finish.

BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL / AWARDS

• Kansas was picked to finish third in the annual Preseason Big 12 Poll, voted on by the league's head coaches. This is the fourth time in program history the Jayhawks have earned a top-three projection and first since being picked second prior to the 2009-10 season.

• Taiyanna Jackson, Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter were all named Preseason All-Big 12 selections, as Jackson was picked unanimously and Kersgieter was an honorable mention selection.

ABOUT THE OPPONENTS

• From Blacksburg, Virginia, the Virginia Tech Hokies are 3-1 on the year and ranked No. 9 in the most recent AP Poll. So far, the Hokies have claimed victories over High Point (94-55), Houston Christian (105-36) and UNCG (72-51). Their sole loss of the season came on Nov. 9, as they fell 80-76 to then-No. 3 Iowa.

• Last season, Virginia Tech made it all the way to the Final Four, before being knocked out by eventual NCAA Champion LSU.

• Three Hokies are averaging double figures this season, led by the 2023 ACC Player of the Year Elizabeth Kitley with 24.2 points per game. Kitley is averaging a double-double with 10.8 rebounds per game along with her scoring.

• Kenny Brooks is in his eighth at the helm in Blacksburg. Last season, he led the Hokies to the program's first ACC title.

• From Hartford, Connecticut, the UConn Huskies enter the Cayman Islands Classic with a record of 3-1 and as the No. 6 team in the latest AP Poll. UConn is led by Aaliyah Edwards (18.0 ppg) and Paige Bueckers (17.8 ppg). Both Edwards and Bueckers have earned a selection on the Naismith Women's Player of the Year Watchlist, joining KU's own Taiyanna Jackson. Bueckers has already earned a plethora of preseason selections, including AP Preseason All-American, Wade Watch List, Ann Myers Drysdale Award Watch List.

• Last season, the Huskies went an impressive 31-6 and claimed the program's 21st Big East title. UConn made it to the Sweet Sixteen before falling to Ohio State 73-61.

• Geno Auriemma is in his 39th season as head coach. He has compiled a career record of 1,180-156, including 11 National Championships.

THE SERIES AGAINST OPPONENTS

- This will be the first time that Kansas has met Virginia Tech in a game in program history.
- Kansas and Connecticut have met two times dating back to 1995. UConn leads the series 2-0.
- The most recent matchup was on December 21, 1996. Kansas fell in that game by a score of 85-64.
- This will be the second neutral-site game against the Huskies. The first was on January 28, 1995, when Kansas lost 97-87 in Kansas City, Missouri.

CHALLENGING NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- Kansas is set for several challenging matchups prior to the start of Big 12 Conference play on December 30, including five of its 13 non-conference games to be played against Power Five opponents.
- KU is competing in the Cayman Islands Classic where, they will face off against perennial powerhouses Virginia Tech and UConn. Virginia Tech played its way to the Final Four in 2023 before eventually falling to National Champion LSU, 79-72.
- The Jayhawks will play two Big Ten opponents, Penn State and Nebraska, and Texas A&M before opening conference play. Last season, Kansas defeated Nebraska in the Super 16 of the WNIT by a score of 64-55. The Jayhawks also hosted Texas A&M and came away with a 32-point victory over the Aggies.

NATIONAL SIGNING DAY RECAP

- Kansas Head Coach Brandon Schneider announced the addition of three student-athletes on Nov. 8 as **Zoe Canfield**, **Carla Osma** and **Regan Williams** signed with the Jayhawks on the first day of the early signing period.
- All three players will join the Jayhawks as freshmen for the 2024-25 season. Canfield and Williams will stay close to home, with Canfield coming to Lawrence from Washburn Rural HS in Topeka, Kansas, while Williams will play her senior season at Link Academy in Branson, Missouri, but originally hails from Kansas City. Osma is a 6-1 guard who will come to Kansas from Madrid, Spain, and reunite with Jayhawk freshman Laia Conesa, a former national team teammate of hers.

MARCH MADNESS COLLEGE ROAD TRIP

- Season 2 of the NCAA March Madness College Road Trip descended upon the University of Kansas to spend a day with the Jayhawks. Autumn Johnson of NCAA.com took a tour of campus, met with Schneider, played M-A-R-C-H against KU's Wyvette Mayberry and interviewed other players on the Kansas women's basketball team throughout the day.

COACHING STAFF ADDITIONS

- Schneider announced one promotion and the addition of two assistant coaches to the coaching staff this offseason.
- Brock McGinnis moves into an assistant coach role after serving on staff as the Director of Player Development for the past four seasons.
- Marqu'es Webb comes to Lawrence after spending the past two seasons as an assistant coach at Mercer. Webb, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, helped Mercer to a 23-7 and an NCAA Tournament appearance in her first season.
- Patrick Schrater returned to Lawrence after spending two years as an assistant coach at Pittsburgh State. Prior to that, Schrater was a graduate assistant for Kansas from 2019-21 following his graduation from Emporia State.

Brandon Schneider is in his ninth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider has led the Jayhawks to the postseason in each of the past two seasons. The 2022-23 season saw Kansas finish with a 25-11 record after winning the WNIT with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks played all six of its WNIT games at home and averaged 3,481 per game for the season, marking a 122 percent increase in home attendance from the 2021-22 season.

KU finished with 25 wins for just the sixth time in program history, and the first since 1996-97. The Jayhawks have now won 20 or more games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2012 and 2013. For his efforts, Schneider was named the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) Women's Four-Year College Coach of the Year in 2023, his third time earning the honor after also claiming in 2006 and 2010 as the head coach at Emporia State. During the 2022-23 season, Schneider became the 33rd active Division I coach to reach 500 career victories, picking up win No. 500 on Feb. 26, 2023, with a 66-57 win over Oklahoma State.

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider guided Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached 11 players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and two named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with six Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 37 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in both 2022 and 2023. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA

COACH BRANDON

Brandon Schneider comes from a coaching family. His father, Bob, was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. For that reason, Bob is 'Coach Schneider' while Brandon prefers to be referred to as 'Coach Brandon.'

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches.

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006 and 2010, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor three times.

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob, was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition, Schneider's brother, Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
