SERIES INFO: Kansas moves to 5-0 in the series against Chaminade and 19-6 all-time in the Maui Invitational (16-6 in games played in Hawaii).

THE KU WIN...

- Made Kansas 4-0 for the 10th time in head coach Bill Self's 21 seasons at KU.
- Improved Kansas to 19-6 in the Maui Invitational (16-6 in games played in Hawaii)
- Extended Kansas' win streak in the Maui Invitational to seven games.
- Made Self 569-132 all-time at Kansas and 776-237 overall.
- Made Kansas 2,374-885 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas has now made 141 field goals on 110 assists. Kansas dished out 29 assists and with 110 through the first four games, it is the most by a team in its first four contests since 1996-97 and most in the Bill Self era.
- Kansas shot 36-of-60 (60.0 percent) for the game. Kansas shot 17-of-30 (56.7 percent) from the floor in the first half and is 3-0 when shooting above 50.0 percent in the first half.
- Kansas' defense held Chaminade to 2-of-12 (16.7 percent) from beyond the arc in the first half.
- Kansas logged a season-high 58 points in the paint and converted on 27 fastbreak points.
- Kansas outrebounded Chaminade 41-26 and never trailed during the contest.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Graduate-senior Kevin McCullar Jr. recorded a triple-double (22 pts, 11 rebs, 10 asts) for a second-consecutive game, which is the first in Kansas men's basketball history. It is the seventh time in NCAA history a player has recorded consecutive triple-doubles, with the last being Tony Lee of Robert Morris on Feb. 9, 2008 and Feb. 14, 2008.
- Senior center Hunter Dickinson posted a KU-career-high 31 points on 15-of-18 (83.3 percent) shooting to go along with 11 rebounds and two steals. Dickinson has now scored 20 or more points in three of four games this season and 37 times for his career. In the first half, Dickinson posted 15 points on 7-of-8 (87.5 percent) shooting. In each of Dickinson's four games with Kansas he has scored in double figures in the first half.
- Redshirt-senior Dajuan Harris Jr. dished out eight assists, tying him for 13th on Kansas' all-time career assists list with Ryan Robertson (1996-99 at KU) at 485. Harris also posted seven points and pulled down four rebounds.
- Junior KJ Adams Jr. logged eight points on 4-of-5 (80.0 percent) shooting and also dished out four assists. Adams has shot 80 percent or better in two of four games this season. He has shot 72.7 percent or better in all four games this season.
- Freshman Elmarko Jackson scored seven points on 2-of-4 (50.0 percent) shooting, dished out three assists and pulled down two rebounds.
- Freshman Johnny Furphy made his first collegiate start for Kansas, scoring four points and pulling down two rebounds.
