THE KU LOSS...

- Made Kansas 4-1 for the first time since also going 4-1 in the 2020-21 season
- Snapped Kansas' seven-game winning streak in the Maui Invitational
- Made Kansas 19-7 all-time in the Maui Invitational, including 16-7 in games played in Hawaii
- Made Bill Self 569-133 while at Kansas and 776-237 overall
- Made Kansas 2,374-886 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot 40.7 percent from the floor on 22-of-54 shooting, which included 26 points in the paint and 15 points off the bench.
- Kansas shot 6-of-17 (35.3 percent) from three-point range.
- Kansas dished out 17 assists, which included three or more from five different players.
- Kansas' 127 assists through the first five games are tied for third all-time in team assists through five games in NCAA history since 1996-97. Kansas tied itself when the 2000-01 team had 127 assists through five games. It is also tied for the most assists in Kansas basketball history through the first five games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Graduate-senior Kevin McCullar Jr. tied his career-high in points with 24 on 9-of-14 (64.2 percent) shooting, accompanied by 14 first-half points which included two three-pointers on three attempts. McCullar also brought down eight rebounds, dished out three assists, recorded a steal and a blocked shot for the game. McCullar has now scored in double figures in each of Kansas' five games, which includes 20 or more points in the last two games.
- Senior Hunter Dickinson scored 13 points on 5-of-10 (50.0 percent) shooting from the floor. Dickinson recorded eight rebounds and has pulled down at least eight rebounds in each of Kansas' five games this season. Dickinson also dished out three assists and recorded two steals.
- Redshirt-senior Dajuan Harris Jr. logged four points and dished out three assists, moving him to 13th on Kansas' all-time career assists list with 488, passing Ryan Robertson's 485.
