SERIES INFO: The Jayhawks move to 9-0 all-time against Kansas City in a series that dates back to 1992.

THE KU WIN...

- Made Kansas 8-1 or better for the sixth-straight season beginning in 2018-19, and the ninth time in the last 10 seasons.
- Made the Kansas-Kansas City series 9-0 in favor of the Jayhawks.
- Gave Kansas 10-straight wins in Allen Fieldhouse, including 5-0 this season, 845-117 all-time in the venue and 304-17 under Bill Self.
- Made Self 150-6 against non-conference opponents in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made Bill Self 573-133 while at Kansas and 780-238 overall.
- Made Kansas 2,378-886 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- In the first half, Kansas shot 53.3 percent (16-of-30) from the floor. The Jayhawks are now 6-0 when shooting better than 50 percent in the opening half of a game.
- Kansas outrebounded the Roos 37-36. Kansas has now won 57-consecutive games when outrebounding its opponent, the longest active streak in the NCAA.
- Kansas finished the contest with 88 points on 54.1 percent (33-of-61) shooting. Kansas is 7-0 on the season when shooting 50 percent or better for the contest.
- Kansas outscored its opponent in the paint, 42-22 and is 7-0 in games when leading in the category.
- Kansas dished out 23 assists on 33 made field goals. It is the sixth game this season with 20 or more assists.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Graduate-senior Kevin McCullar Jr. posted a career-high 25 points on 9-of-13 (69.2 percent) shooting. It is McCullar's fifth 20+ point game of the season and eighth of his career. McCullar also pulled down six boards, dished out five assists and went a perfect 2-of-2 from deep.
- Junior KJ Adams Jr. added a season-high tying 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting while pulling down seven boards and dishing out a career-high six assists. Adams' previous career high of five assists came against West Virginia on Feb. 25, 2023. Adams also notched a game high and career-high tying four steals in the win.
- Senior Hunter Dickinson recorded his 36th-career double-double and fifth of the season with 14 points and 12 rebounds on 50.0 percent (6-of-12) shooting. Kansas is now 5-0 when Dickinson records 10+ rebounds in a game.
- Freshman Johnny Furphy ended the contest with 10 points, all of which came in the second half. Furphy connected on two three-pointers and shot 57.1 percent (4-of-7) from the floor. It is the second game this season Furphy has posted double-digit scoring. Furphy also grabbed two steals and blocked a shot.
- Redshirt-senior Dajuan Harris Jr. posted eight points to go along with a game-high seven assists. Harris went 3-of-6 from the floor, two of which coming from beyond the arc. Harris has made multiple threes for the second time this season and it is the 17th time of his career that he has made multiple threes in a game.
- Freshman Elmarko Jackson tallied five points and three assists in his ninth start in as many games.
