THE KU WIN...

- Extended Kansas' conference opener win streak to 33 games, a streak that started in 1991-92.
- Made Kansas 13-1 or better for the third-straight season.
- Extended Kansas' win streak to nine games.
- Gave Kansas 13-straight wins in Allen Fieldhouse, including 8-0 this season.
- Made Bill Self 578-133 while at Kansas, 785-238 overall and 30-7 versus TCU (23-4 while at KU).
- Made Kansas 2,383-886 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot 53.3 percent (32-of-60) from the field. That is the highest shooting percentage in a conference opener since Jan. 2, 2016 at Baylor (53.7 percent).
- Kansas grabbed a season-high 16 offensive rebounds. The Jayhawks have secured double-digit offensive rebounds in three-straight games and four of the last five contests. The last time Kansas had at least 16 offensive rebounds in a conference game was March 10, 2022 vs. West Virginia (16).
- Kansas outrebounded TCU 40-28 to extend the Jayhawks win streak to 61-straight games when securing more rebounds than its opponent.
- Kansas had two players finish with a double-double in the same game for the second time this season (Nov. 20, 2023 vs. Chaminade).
- The contest had 11 ties and a season-high 26 lead changes.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior center Hunter Dickinson recorded his Big 12-best ninth double-double of the season with 30 points on 13-of-20 (65.0 percent) shooting and 11 rebounds in 35 minutes. Dickinson has grabbed at least 10 rebounds in six-straight games and the double-double was the 40th of his career. The six-game stretch of double-digit rebounds is the longest of Dickinson's career. Dickinson's eight offensive rebounds were a season high by a Jayhawk and the most since David McCormack grabbed 10 offensive rebounds on Jan. 15, 2022 vs. West Virginia. The 30-point effort was Dickinson's second game of the season with 30-plus points (31, Nov. 20, 2023 vs. Chaminade) and the fifth of his career.
- Junior forward KJ Adams Jr. posted his first career double-double with 18 points on 7-of-8 (87.5 percent) shooting and 10 rebounds in 37 minutes. Adams has at least 10 rebounds in each of the last two games after never doing it once in his first 95 games.
- Graduate-senior guard Kevin McCullar Jr. had 16 points, five rebounds and three assists in 38 minutes. McCullar has double-digit points in all 14 games this season and 16 consecutive contests dating back to last season. McCullar's streak of made free throws was snapped at 24, which is tied for the sixth-longest in program history.
- Redshirt-senior guard Dajuan Harris Jr. moved into 10th on the KU career assists list with 553. He passed Sherron Collins (2007-10) who had 552. Harris finished with 10 points, three rebounds and eight assists in 39 minutes. The Jayhawks improved to 29-1 when Harris scores 10 or more points.
