### TIPOFF

• The Kansas Jayhawks will open play in 2024 with a road trip to Ames, Iowa, to face the Iowa State Cyclones on Wednesday, Jan. 3, at Hilton Coliseum.

• Tipoff is set for 6:30 p.m. CT and the game will be televised on Big 12 NOW on ESPN+ with Larry Morgan (play-by-play) and Molly Parrott (analyst) on the call. Fans can also listen to the game on the Jayhawk Radio Network from Learfield, with Steven Davis calling the action.

• Kansas opened Big 12 play on Dec. 30, suffering an 85-60 defeat to No. 25 West Virginia, which snapped a 13-game winning streak by the Jayhawks at Allen Fieldhouse. KU is now 7-5 on the year, with three defeats coming against Top 25 opponents, and 0-1 in league play for the first time since 2021-22.

• The Jayhawks are headed to face Iowa State at Hilton Coliseum, where KU has not won since 2015. Kansas has dropped eight-straight games against ISU on the road, but the Jayhawks won the last meeting in the series, defeating the Cyclones 98-93 on March 1, 2023, at Allen Fieldhouse.

• Iowa State is 8-4 on the year and 1-0 in Big 12 play following a 76-68 victory at Oklahoma State on Dec. 30. The Cyclones have won four-straight games and six of their past seven heading into the new calendar year.

• Kansas and Iowa State have met 96 times in women's basketball dating back to 1978, and the all-time series is tied at 48-48. Last season, the two teams split the season series, with each team winning on its home court.

### KANSAS NOTES

• Kansas is led by four returning starters, including two fifth-year seniors who continue to climb up the record boards. Holly Kersgieter scored a team-high 19 points in the Big 12 opener against West Virginia, moving past Tamecka Dixon (1993-97) for ninth place on KU's all-time scoring list with 1,692 career points. Kersgieter is now closing in on the three-point shooting record at Kansas. She has hit 233

threes during her career as a Jayhawk, which is four away from the record of 237 set by Angie Halbleib from 1994-97.

• Zakiyah Franklin, who has already set the school record for minutes played, is now third in games played at Kansas with 133 and will tie Monica Engelman (2010-13) for second with her next action. Franklin is 10th on KU's all-time scoring list with 1,665 points and fourth in school history with 459 career assists.

• Now in her third season as a Jayhawk, Taiyanna Jackson is closing in multiple milestones. She is 32 points away from 1,000 for her career, 13 rebounds away from the top 10 in Kansas Women's Basketball history and 35 blocked shots away from KU's school record. Jackson is second on the team with 13.1 points per game this season, while leading the Jayhawks with 9.8 rebounds per game after recording her seventh double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds against West Virginia.


• S'Mya Nichols got off to a slow start in conference play, as she was held to a season-low five points while battling foul trouble against WVU. Nichols remains KU's leading scorer, averaging 13.3 points per game for the season and the freshman from Overland Park, Kansas, has scored 10 or more points nine times this season. After scoring 20+ points in consecutive games against Houston Christian and Wichita State, Nichols was named the Big 12 Freshman of the Week on Dec. 11, becoming the first Jayhawk to claim the award in three seasons.

• Senior Wyvette Mayberry is fifth on the team in scoring at 9.8 points per game, while ranking second on the team with 29 assists and 16 made threes.

### UP NEXT

• Kansas plays its second road game of the week with a trip to Lubbock, Texas, to face Texas Tech on Saturday, Jan. 6. Tipoff from United Supermarkets Arena is set for 2 p.m. CT and the game will be broadcast on Big 12 NOW on ESPN+.

**Taiyanna Jackson** is in her third and final season at Kansas, where she is ranked second on the all-time Kansas blocks list. Jackson has broken the single-season blocks record in each of her first two seasons at KU and is fourth in career double-doubles, recording her 34th against West Virginia.



**Zakiah Franklin** became the program leader in career minutes against Northwestern State on Nov. 8. She has played 4,343 minutes in 133 career games. Franklin is No. 10 on KU's career scoring list and eighth in career free throws made, while ranking fourth with 459 career assists.



**Holly Kersgieter** moved to 8th on KU's career scoring list after scoring 19 points against West Virginia on Dec. 30. She is closing in on KU's career record for three-point field goals made, ranks ninth in free throws made, 10th in career minutes and tied for eighth in career games (128).

**ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS**

- Kansas is 7-5 on the season and 0-1 in Big 12 play after dropping the conference opener, 85-60 to No. 25 West Virginia on Dec. 30 at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks are now 0-3 against nationally ranked opponents this season.
- Kansas enters the new year ranked No. 55 in the latest NET rankings, which takes into account games played through Dec. 31. The NET rankings are based off of game results, winning percentage and adjusted win percentage. KU is the eighth-highest ranked team from the Big 12, which has 13-of-14 members ranked in the Top 100.
- Kansas returned four starters from 2022-23, including Preseason All-Big 12 selections Taiyanna Jackson, Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter. Jackson earned a unanimous selection, while Franklin was on the preseason team and Kersgieter received honorable mention.
- Kansas entered the 2023-24 season after claiming the 2023 WNIT Championship with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse on April 1. Jackson was named the WNIT Most Valuable Player after posting 17 points and 21 rebounds in the finale. Jackson set the tournament record for most rebounds (78) and most offensive rebounds (33) in a postseason WNIT.

**TWIN**

- Hailing from East Chicago, Indiana, Taiyanna Jackson is in her third season at Kansas and she has broken the single-season blocks record in both of her previous seasons. She burst on to the scene with 95 blocks in her first season at KU, then surpassed that record with 109 blocks in 2022-23. Jackson is averaging 2.8 blocks per game this season and now has 235 blocked shots for her career, needing 35 to break KU's career record. She had a season-high six blocks in KU's win at Wichita State on Dec. 10.
- Prior to the start of the 2023-24 season, Jackson was named to the Naismith Player of the Year Watch List, which recognizes the best overall player in NCAA Division I women's basketball. She is one of 50 selections to the list.
- Entering the 2023-24 season, Jackson earned a unanimous selection on the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. She has earned this recognition after being named to the All-Big 12 First Team and the All-Big 12 Defensive Team, both unanimously, and a two-time Big 12 Player of the Week in 2022-23.
- Jackson is also one of 20 players named to the Lisa Leslie Preseason Award Watch List. Jackson finished the 2022-23 campaign posting 23 double-doubles, the third-most in a single-season in Kansas history, and ranked second in KU history with a field goal percentage of 66.1, which ranked fourth nationally.

**PRESEASON WATCH LISTS**

- Zakiyah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson have both been named to preseason award watch lists heading into the 2023-24 season.
- Franklin is one of 20 players selected to the Nancy Liberman Preseason Award Watch List, which recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Franklin led the Jayhawks in scoring with 15.7 points per game last season and has started 127 games in her career at Kansas, scoring 1,665 career points.
- Jackson earned a spot on two watch lists, being recognized as one of 20 candidates for the Lisa Leslie Award, which recognizes the best center in college basketball, and one of 50 for the Naismith Player of the Year Award.

**FIVE-STAR FRESHMAN**

- S'Mya Nichols came to KU as one of the highest-ranked recruits in program history when she signed to become a Jayhawk, and early in her career she has lived up to the billing.
- Nichols has scored in double figures nine times in her first 12 games at Kansas, leading the Jayhawks in scoring four times. Nichols set a new career-high in scoring in back-to-back games, scoring 20 points in KU's win over Houston Christian (Dec. 6), before going for 23 points in the win at Wichita State (Dec. 10).
- For her efforts, Nichols was named the Big 12 Freshman of the Week on Dec. 11, becoming the first KU payer since 2020 to earn the league's weekly freshman honor.
- A five-star prospect from Shawnee Mission West HS in Overland Park, Kansas, Nichols was ranked No. 5 at her position and No. 22 in the country by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report. As a member of the 2022 Team USA U18 National Team, she won a gold medal at the FIBA U18 Americas Championship.

**KANSAS NOTES**

- Two current Jayhawks rank in the Top 10 for all-time scoring in Kansas. Holly Kersgieter moved into eighth with 19 points against West Virginia, giving her 1,692 career points, while Zakiyah Franklin moved to 10th during KU's win over Central Arkansas and currently has 1,665 career points. The next player ahead of Kersgieter is Lynn Pride, who scored 1,774 points from 1996-2000, while Franklin is closing in on Tamecka Dixon, who scored 1,689 points as a Jayhawk from 1993-97.
- KU has had two players surpass the 1,000-point career milestone during the non-conference portion of the schedule. Wyvette Mayberry, who started her career at Tulsa, reached the milestone in the Jayhawks' season opener against Northwestern State on Nov. 8. Ryan Cobbins, who played a combined four seasons at North Dakota State and Alabama, scored her 1,000th point in KU's win over Central Arkansas on Dec. 16.
- Kersgieter has moved up to second place on KU's career three-point shooting list, surpassing Kylee Kopatch during Kansas' win over Nebraska on Dec. 20. Kersgieter, who has hit 233 threes as a Jayhawk, now has her sites set on the school record, which is held by Angie Halbleib, who hit 237 three-pointers from 1994-97.

**BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL / AWARDS**

- Kansas was picked to finish third in the annual Preseason Big 12 Poll, voted on by the league's head coaches. This is the fourth time in program history the Jayhawks have earned a top-three projection and first since being picked second prior to the 2009-10 season.
- Taiyanna Jackson, Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter were all named Preseason All-Big 12 selections, as Jackson was picked unanimously and Kersgieter was an honorable mention selection.

**ABOUT THE OPPONENT**

- From Ames, Iowa, the Cyclones have won four-straight games and six of their past seven to improve to 8-4 on the year. ISU is 1-0 in Big 12 play after winning 76-68 at Oklahoma State on Dec. 30 in the conference opener.
- Iowa State, who was picked sixth in the Big 12 preseason poll, ranks seventh in the league in scoring, averaging 78.3 points per game while opponents are scoring 65.3 points on average against ISU.
- Three players are scoring in double figures for the Cyclones, led by Audi Crooks (16.5) and Addy

Brown (14.5). Brown also leads ISU in rebounding, averaging 9.0 rebounds per game. The Cyclones are second in the Big 12 in three-point shooting, averaging 9.1 made threes per game this season.

- ISU is led by the dean of Big 12 women's basketball coaches, Bill Fennelly, who has led the Cyclones to 21 NCAA Tournaments and a record of 598-305 in 29 seasons.

THE SERIES

- The longtime conference rivalry between Kansas and Iowa State dates back to 1978 and the two programs have split the 96 all-time meetings, with the series tied at 48-48.
- Last season, Kansas split the season series with ISU, defeating the Cyclones 98-93 on March 1, 2023 in Lawrence to snap a 16-game winning streak by ISU in the series.

THE NEWCOMERS

- KU welcomed six newcomers to the squad, highlighted by five-star guard S'Mya Nichols out of Overland Park, Kansas.
- The most experienced of the group is Alabama transfer Ryan Cobbins as she enters her fifth season of college basketball. Along with Nichols and Cobbins, Skyler Gill transferred from North Alabama where she was a two-time ASUN Conference Player of the Year and All-ASUN Second Team Selection.
- The squad also welcomes three more freshmen in guard Laia Conesa, center Paris Gaines and guard McKenzie Smith. Conesa hails from Barcelona, Spain, where she competed in the FIBA U16 European Challengers, FIBA U17 Women's Basketball World Cup, as she helped Spain to a runner-up finish.

CHALLENGING NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- With a 69-52 victory over Nebraska on Dec. 20, Kansas concluded a challenging 11-game non-conference slate that prepared the Jayhawks for the start of Big 12 Conference play.
- KU entered league play with a NET Ranking of No. 43 after going 7-4 during a non-conference slate that included five power conference opponents. The Jayhawks faced two nationally-ranked opponents in No. 9 Virginia Tech and No. 6 UConn at the inaugural Cayman Islands Classic, and went on the road to face Penn State and Texas A&M.

NATIONAL SIGNING DAY RECAP

- Kansas Head Coach Brandon Schneider announced the addition of three student-athletes on Nov. 8 as **Zoe Canfield**, **Carla Osma** and **Regan Williams** signed with the Jayhawks on the first day of the early signing period.
- All three players will join the Jayhawks as freshmen for the 2024-25 season. Canfield and Williams will stay close to home, with Canfield coming to Lawrence from Washburn Rural HS in Topeka, Kansas, while Williams will play her senior season at Link Academy in Branson, Missouri, but originally hails from Kansas City. Osma is a 6-1 guard who will come to Kansas from Madrid, Spain, and reunite with Jayhawk freshman Laia Conesa, a former national team teammate of hers.

EUROPEAN TRIP IN REVIEW

- This summer, the Kansas women's basketball team took an informational and educational European trip, spanning from Aug. 6-16. The team visited Rome and Sorrento, Italy and Athens, Greece.
- In addition to siteseeing in both locations, the team faced two National Select Teams, Italian Select and Greek Select. The Jayhawks won both contests by a combined score of 207-110.

**Brandon Schneider** is in his ninth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider has led the Jayhawks to the postseason in each of the past two seasons. The 2022-23 season saw Kansas finish with a 25-11 record after winning the WNIT with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks played all six of its WNIT games at home and averaged 3,481 per game for the season, marking a 122 percent increase in home attendance from the 2021-22 season.

KU finished with 25 wins for just the sixth time in program history, and the first since 1996-97. The Jayhawks have now won 20 or more games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2012 and 2013. For his efforts, Schneider was named the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) Women's Four-Year College Coach of the Year in 2023, his third time earning the honor after also claiming in 2006 and 2010 as the head coach at Emporia State. During the 2022-23 season, Schneider became the 33rd active Division I coach to reach 500 career victories, picking up win No. 500 on Feb. 26, 2023, with a 66-57 win over Oklahoma State.

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider guided Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached 11 players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and two named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with six Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 37 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in both 2022 and 2023. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA in the 2021 fall semester.

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches.

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006 and 2010, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor three times.

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob, was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition, Schneider's brother, Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
