THE KU WIN...

- Made Kansas 19-5 on the season and 7-4 in Big 12 play.
- Improved Kansas to 120-18 under Bill Self in games following a loss.
- Made the Kansas-Baylor series 36-9 in favor of Kansas, including 20-1 in meetings Lawrence (19-1 in Allen Fieldhouse).
- Extended Kansas' home-court winning streak to 18 games, including 13-0 this season. That is tied for the second longest active home winning streak in Division I men's college basketball.
- Made Kansas 853-117 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, including 312-17 under Bill Self
- Made Bill Self 791-242 all-time, including 584-136 and 28-9 all-time against Baylor (28-8 while at Kansas).
- Made Kansas 2,389-890 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas has posted six wins against AP Top 25 teams this season. That is tied for the most in the country (Purdue).
- Kansas has won 70-straight games in Allen Fieldhouse when leading at the halftime, dating back to the beginning of the 2018-19 season.
- Kansas swiped 17 steals against Baylor. The 17 steals are the most by Kansas in a conference game since Jan. 27, 2007 vs. Colorado (19).
- Kansas improved to 122-55 in games decided by five points or fewer or overtime under Bill Self.
- Kansas forced Baylor into 21 turnovers. That is the most by a Kansas opponent this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Hunter Dickinson had team highs of 15 points and seven rebounds in 32 minutes. Dickinson has scored in double figures in 23 of 24 games this season.
- Redshirt senior Dajuan Harris Jr. contributed 14 points, five assists and two steals in 36 minutes. Kansas is 31-2 when Harris scores at least 10 points.
- Junior KJ Adams Jr. posted 13 points on 6-of-7 (85.7 percent) shooting, four rebounds, two assists and three steals in 36 minutes. Adams has finished in double figures in 11-straight contests.
- Freshman Johnny Furphy added 11 points on a perfect 7-of-7 clip from the free throw line, five rebounds and a career-high six steals in 36 minutes. His six steals were the most by a Kansas freshman since Xavier Henry had seven steals on Jan. 20, 2010 vs. Baylor.
- Freshman Elmarko Jackson recorded a career-high four steals.
