## THE KU WIN...

- Made Kansas 20-6 and 8-5 in Big 12 play.
- Made Kansas 7-2 against Associated Press ranked teams this season.
- Extended Kansas' win streak to seven games against Oklahoma, including wins in 10 of the last 11 meetings.
- Made Kansas 2-0 against Oklahoma this season.
- Gave Kansas 20 wins in 34 of its last 35 seasons, beginning in 1989-90.
- Made Kansas 121-18 in the Bill Self era following a loss.
- Made Kansas 3-5 in true road games this season and 7-6 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made Bill Self 585-138 while at Kansas, 792-243 overall and 29-8 all-time against Oklahoma, 29-6 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,390-891 all-time.

## TEAM NOTES

- Kansas outrebounded Oklahoma, 40-29. Kansas is 64-2 in its last 66 games when outrebounding their opponent.
- The game was tied five times with two lead changes.
- Kansas outscored Oklahoma 30-14 in the paint.

## INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior center Hunter Dickinson recorded his Big 12-leading 14th double-double, posting 20 points on 9-of-16 (56.3 percent) shooting and pulling down 16 boards. Dickinson now has 45 career double-doubles. Dickinson has three games of 20 or more points and 15 or more rebounds this season.
- Freshman guard Johnny Furphy put together 15 points and nine rebounds on 5-of-8 (62.5 percent) shooting, which included a 3-of-5 (60.0 percent) clip from beyond the arc. Furphy has scored in double figures in 11 games this season and his nine boards are the second-most on the season, following his career high of 11 against Cincinnati. Furphy added a game-high three steals.
- Redshirt-senior guard Dajuan Harris Jr. finished with 11 points and a game-high seven assists. Kansas is 32-2 when Harris scores at least 10 points.
- Graduate guard Kevin McCullar Jr. returned to action after missing the previous two games. McCullar had 10 points and pulled in eight boards in 35 minutes.
- Junior forward KJ Adams Jr. added nine points and picked two steals.
