## **OUICK HITS**

- Texas State dropped its first game of the season at No. 5 TCU on Tuesday by a score of 6-5. It was the team's fifth consecutive road loss dating back to last season. The last road victory for the Bobcats was on May 2, 2023 with a 10-5 win at Incarnate Word.
- In Tuesday's game, Aaron Lugo hit his second homer of the season with it being an inside-the-park home run. It was the first inside-the-parker was the first by a Bobcat since Tyler Sibley did so at Bobcat Ballpark against Houston on Mar. 11, 2011. A member of the Cougars' coaching staff that is current TXST head coach Steven Trout.
- The Bobcat pitching staff has shine so far just four games into the season. The team has a 1.91 ERA with 37 strikeouts and holding opponents to a .175 batting average. The bullpen has posted a 1.45 ERA in 18.2 innings with 23 punchouts to just five walks.
- Ryne Farber is off to an incredible start at the plate. The freshman is batting .750 (9-for-12), which is fourth in the nation, with seven runs and three doubles. He has also leads the team with five walks and two hit by pitches for an .842 OBP while not striking out.
- Last year, Texas State set a team record with five batters hitting 10 or more home runs, surpassing the previous mark of four set in 2022. Returning from that quintet is Chase Mora (17), Cade Manning (10), Daylan Pena (10) and August Ramirez (10) while the only departure was Jose Gonzalez who hit 12 round trippers.
- Mora's 17 homers were tied for the fourth most ever on the team's all-time season list. He matched the campaign totals by Paul Goldschmidt (2008) and Gary Herrmann (1992). Mora hit the most round trippers by a Bobcats since Casey Kalenkosky set the program mark of 21 in 2011.
- In the preseason, Mora was was recognized for his performance by being named to the NCBWA Preseason All-America Second Team and the All-Sun Belt Conference Preseason Team at second base.

#### SCOUTING KANSAS

- Kansas is 2-2 on the year and have won two straight.
- Claimed the series finale agianst UIW at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi and won Tuesday night at the stadium versus Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.
- Were picked to finish eighth in the 13-team Big XII Conference.
- Kodey Shojinaga leads the Jayhawks with a .500 average (9-for-18) with three home runs, eight RBI, six runs and two doubles.
- Jake English enters batting .444 with three homers, seven RBI and seven runs.
- Also with two round trippers is Ben Hartl (6 RBI).
- Scheduled to take the rubber Friday night is Reese Dunton. The senior righthander gave up three runs on four hits and two walks while striking out three in three innings in the season opening loss to UIC.
- Grant Adler (3.86 ERA) has tossed a team-high 4.2 innings of relief and leads all pitchers with seven strikeouts.

### **ALL-TIME VS. THE JAYHAWKS**

- The all-time series is tied 1-1.
- Both previous meetings have taken place at a neutral site.
- $\bullet$  Most recent meeting also came at Dell Diamond with the Jayhawks winning 9-3 on Feb. 10, 2001.
- First matchup was on Feb. 26, 1995 in Houston that the Bobcats won 8-6.

# TXST AGAINST THE BIG XII

- Texas State is 95-192 all-time against current members of the Big XII Conference.
- Most games (79) and wins (26) have been against Baylor.
- The most losses (54) have been to Texas.
- Lone team the Bobcats have a winning record against is UCF at 2-0.
- TXST has a .500 mark against BYU (2-2), Kansas (1-1), Kansas State (1-1) and Oklahoma (5-5).
- Only members that Texas State has not played is Cincinnati and West Virginia.

### SCOUTING KENTUCKY

- Kentucky enters the weekend 4-0.
- Swept the opening series at USC Upstate and claimed their home opener on Tuesday agianst Morehead State.
- Was picked to finish fifth in the SEC West.
- Ty Crittenberger is hitting a team best .500 while hitting one of the team's four
- Nick Lopez comes in with a .455 average and team-high three doubles.
- Grant Smith and Ryan Nicholson pace the squad with six and four RBI, respectively
- The Wildcats are 14-for-14 stealing bases with eight guys swiping a bag. A teamhigh three have been stolen by Devin Burkes.
- Projected to start on Saturday is left-hander Dominic Niman. In his first start, he struck out six in five scoreless innings to earn the win.
- Johnny Hummel has earned the team's lone save. Over two appearances, he has not allowed a baserunner and struck out four
- Also making two relief appearances and tossing 2.1 innings apiece has been Jackson Nove (1-0, 0.00 ERA) and Cameron O'Brien (3.86 ERA, 3 K).

# TXST AGAINST THE SEC

- Against current members of the SEC, Texas State is 14-55 all-time.
- The most games (62), wins (14) and losses (48) have been againt Texas A&M.
- Bobcats have also faced Arkansas (0-1), Florida (0-1), LSU (0-3) and Missouri (0-3).
- Saturday is the first time TXST has faced an SEC program outside of Texas since 2011 when the team played Arkansas and Missouri.

# **SCOUTING WASHINGTON STATE**

- Slated to get the ball on Sunday is Spencer Jones. The lefty is 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA and four strikeouts over 5.1 innings. Of his five hits, three have gone for extra-bases with two homers and one double.
- The lone save has been earned by Jacob Gabler after recording one out in his lone appearance.
- Both Andrew Baughn (3.00 ERA, 3 IP, 1 K) and Chase Grillo (3.86 ERA, 2.1 IP, 3 K) have made a team-high two relief appearances.

#### ALL-TIME VS. COUGARS

- Texas State leads the all-time series 4-3.
- Last time the teams played was to open the 2016 season in San Marcos and saw the Bobcats win the first three games of the four-game series.
- Teams also met for a three-game series in Pullman, Wash. from Mar. 7-8, 2016 as the the Cougars won the first two contests and the Bobcats claimed the series finale 5-3.

### **TXST AGAINST THE PAC-12**

- Texas State is 11-15 against current members of the Pac-12 Conference.
- Most games (7) and wins (4) are against Washington State while the most losses (4) have been to Washington.
- Bobcats have a .500 or better record against Arizona (2-1), California (1-0), Oregon (2-2) and Utah (1-0).
- Only time TXST has faced a Pac-12 team in the NCAA Tournament was in 2022 at the Stanford Regional when the Bobcats faced the Cardinals three times and going 1-2.

## **TROUT ERA**

- The 2024 season marks the fifth under the leadership of Steven Trout.
- Trout is the sixth head coach in program history and the fifth in the team's Division I history.
- It will be Trout's 11th season with the Bobcats after serving two years each as the associate head coach (2018-19), assistant coach (2016-17) and volunteer assistant (2009-10).
- This is Trout's second head coaching jobs and first at the NCAA Division I level. He was the head coach at Texarkana College in 2012, the team's final season before all of the athletic programs were disbanded. Trout went 34-25 in his lone season leading the Bulldogs.

# **TXST HEAD COACHING VICTORIES**

- Head Coach Steven Trout has won 121 games leading the Texas State program.
- His victory total is the fourth most in team history, which he reached after the Bobcats won 6-1 at UT Arlington on Apr. 14, 2022.
- Trout won his 100th game on Mar. 31, 2022 in a 10-inning affair versus Arkansas State.
- Next on the list is Howard Bushong with 171 wins.
- The Bobcats' all-time winningest head coach is Ty Harrington with 657 victories.

- Casey Kalenkosky, Kyle Kubitza and Jeff McVaney are the only trio to all reach 20 career home runs together as they did so in the 2011 season.
- Only 18 Texas State players have ever hit 20 career homers.
- The program record is 36 held by Paul Goldschmidt.

## **WALK-OFF ENDINGS**

- Since the start of the 2019 season, Texas State has gone 20-7 in games that have ended via a walk-off.
- This season the Bobcats are 1-0 with a run-rule walk-off against Youngstown State in the series finale.
- The past two years saw TXST go 4-1 in each campaign while posting a 2-4 mark in 2021, 3-0 in 2020 and 6-1 in 2019.

## **MULTIPLE BIG XII VICTORIES**

- Texas State will look to extend its streak to four consecutive years with multiple victories over Big XII Conference teams.
- Last season saw the Bobcats go 2-2 against the Big XII with wins over #11 TCU and #19 Texas.
- In, 2022, TXST claimed victories agaisnt #1 Texas and Baylor and the 2021 season saw the Bobcats defeat Oklahoma and the Horned Frogs.
- The 2021 season was the first time since 2016 Texas State defeated multiple Big XII foes in a season.
- Texas State has five games reaminging agianst Bix XII opponents this season with contests versus Houston (1), Kansas (1) and Texas (3).

# **SUN BELT OPENERS**

- Texas State is 6-3 all-time in the Sun Belt Conference opener.
- Last season saw the Bobcats fall to Southern Miss and have now dropped three of their last four games to start league play.
- Lone win in that time came in 2022 against Arkansas State while the other two defeats came against Little Rock (2021) and South Alabama (2019).
- TXST won its first five openers as a member of the Sun Belt.
- In the first Sun Belt series of a season, Texas State is 19-8 all-time after winning the series over the Golden Eagles last year.
- The Bobcats have swept the first Sun Belt series four times (2014, 2016, 2018, 2022)

# **RUN-RULE VICTORIES**

- Since the 2020 season, Texas State has won nine games by run-rule with seven of them coming at home.
- Thie Bobcats picked up their first such victory this year in the series finale agianst the Penguins.
- Last season, TXST had just one run-rule win with it coming in the regular seaon finale against ULM.
- Also posted three run-rule victories in 2022 and had two apiece in 2021 and 2020.

# **NEW CONFERENCE RUN RULE**

- This year, the Sun Belt Conference has implented a new rule for league games.
- All games will end after seven innings (6.5 if the home team is winning) if a team is winning by 10 or more runs.
- This is copying a rule implentmented last season by the SEC.
- Previously, only the series finale if a team was flying would a 10-run rule be applied to conference games.

# **DRAFTED BOBCATS**

- Levi Wells was selected in the 2023 MLB Draft back in July.
- He was selected in the fourth round with the 118th overall pick by Baltimore.
- The right-handed pitcher was the fourth highest drafted Bobcat in program history and the fifth ever to be taken within the first five rounds.
- Last time a TXST player was a top five round pick was Kyle Kubitza in 2011

- when Atlanta took him in the third round.
- His selection marked the 20th year in the last 21 that a Bobcat was drafted. The lone exception was in 2020 due to the draft being shortened to just five rounds.
- Wells was the 77th TXST player drafted in program history.

#### PROCAT

- Heading into the 2024 season, 10 former Texas State players are playing professional baseball with eight in a Major League Baseball organization and two competing with an independent league team.
- Playing in the majors are Kyle Finnegan (Washington) and Paul Goldschmidt (St. Louis). Goldschmidt won the 2022 NL MVP award and is the second player from a college/university in the Lone Star State to win an MVP award, joining Roger Clemens (Texas) in 1986.
- Hunter McMahon ended 2023 pitching for St. Paul, the AAA team of the Minnesota Twins
- Four former Bobcats reached AA level in Nick Fraze (New Hampshire; Toronto), Zachary Leigh (Tennessee; Chicago Cubs), Dalton Shuffield (Wichita; Minnesota) and Tristan Stivors (Birmingtham; Chicago White Sox).
- Levi Wells was selected in the fourth round of the 2023 MLB Draft by Baltimore but did not appear in any games after signing with the organization.
- Jaylen Hubbard competed his second season with the Grand Junction Jackalopes of the independ Pioneer League. He set a league record with 117 RBI and hit a franchise record 25 home runs in 2023. This season, Hubbard has signed to play with the Cleburne Railroaders of the American Association of Professional Baseball.
- Jose Gonzalez will play for the Yolo High Wheelers out of Davis, California. He is coming a Bobcat career in which he hit 33 home runs, the second most in team history.


