The Cougars opened the 2024 season by taking three of four at Utah Tech last weekend. WSU hit nine home runs and 10 doubles while the defense committed just two errors and turned five double plays. On the mound, Grant Taylor worked through five innings to earn the opening day win, Connor Wilford struck out six in a career-high six shutout innings to take game one of Saturday's doubleheader while Duke Brotherton, Kevin Haynes, Andrew Baughn and Chase Grillo combined for just one earned run in Sunday's finale. Designated hitter Casen Taggart led the way offensively with a .500 batting average while outfielder Alan Shibley hit .471 with seven of his eight hits going for extra bases.

#### **COUGARS TO PLAY 15 GAMES ON PAC-12 NETWORKS**

WSU will play 15 games on the Pac-12 Networks in 2024. The five Pac-12 Conference series televised will be the Cougars most televised games since 2017. The final weekend of March will see Washington State head to Seattle for The Boeing Apple Cup Series against Washington set for a Thursday-Saturday series, March 28-30. The next three home conference series will be televised; California (April 12-14), Oregon State (May 3-5), USC (May 10-12). The final weekend of the regular season will see the Cougars head to Eugene for a Thursday-Saturday (May 16-18) series on the Pac-12 Networks.

#### NATHAN CHOATE NAMED COUGAR BASEBALL HEAD COACH

Nathan Choate was named the 18th head baseball coach in program history this past June. Choate arrived at WSU after leading Loyola Marymount to a 2023 West Coast Conference title while guiding the Lions to new heights in his four seasons leading the program. Choate was named the 2023 WCC Coach of the Year after leading LMU to their first outright regular season title in 25 years. He coached a pair of Lions to All-America honors while five players earned All-WCC honors in addition to the WCC Pitcher of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year. Choate's 2023 LMU club tallied road wins at Vanderbilt and Oklahoma State while in the classroom, the Lions posted a 3.18 team GPA including 24 players with a 3.0 or higher. Throughout his coaching career, Choate has accumulated 28 players selected in the MLB Draft, seven of which went in the top-10 rounds, 10 All-Americans, two Col[1]lege World Series appearances, three Team USA pitchers, four Fresh[1]man All-Americans, two Big West Freshman Pitchers of the Year, two WCC Pitchers of the Year and nine All-Conference Pitchers. "My family and I couldn't be more excited to join the Washington State University family. Thank you to President Schulz, Pat Chun and Mitch Straub for the opportunity to lead the baseball program," Choate said. We look forward to earning the respect of past, current, and future Cougs, as well as the Pullman Community. Go Cougs!"

#### LAST SEASON

Washington State finished the season with a 29-23 overall record including a 10-19 mark in Pac-12 Conference play. The 29 wins were the most since 2015 and marked the fourth-straight winning season after posting series wins at No. 15 Oregon State, No. 12 UCLA, Arizona, Santa Clara, at California and season series win over Gonzaga. The Cougars led the Pac-12 in hit-by-pitch (91), were third in stolen bases (70) and hit the 10th-most home runs in WSU history while the pitching staff was second in the league averaging 10.2 strikeouts/9 innings.

#### **COUGAR BASEBALL RETURNED TO TOP-25 FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2010**

In mid March last season, Washington State Baseball returned to the National Top-25 for the first time since 2010, appearing at No. 20 in the March 13 Collegiate Baseball Poll after taking two for three at No. 15 Oregon State the previous weekend. The Cougars took two of three in Corvallis for their first series win in Corvallis since 2009. The Cougars finished the 2010 season ranked No. 21 by Collegiate Baseball and No. 24 by Baseball America.

#### **COUGAR COACHING STAFF**

Joe Perez begins his first season as the Cougars Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator and will serve as the infield coach and assist with the hitters after working the previous eight seasons as the Associated Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator at Central Arizona College, one of the premier junior college programs in the country, where worked with the infielders and hitters. Perez, the 2021 ABCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, helped the Vaqueros to a pair of Junior College National Championships, three Western District titles, two Region I Championships and three ACCAC Conference Championships. Prior to his time at Central Arizona, Perez spent four seasons at Grand Canyon University where he worked with Choate for Head Coach Andy Stankiewicz assisting with Infielders.

Quinn Hawksworth begins his first season as a assistant coach and will work with the Cougar hitters and assist with recruiting, after working the past three seasons at CSU Bakersfield competing in the Big West Conference. Hawksworth joined CSU Bakersfield Baseball prior to the 2021 season where he worked with hitters, infielders and recruiting before being promoted to recruiting coordinator following the 2022 season. Hawksworth went to Bakersfield after spending the 2020 season in a volunteer position at Big West Conference power, UC Santa Barbara where he coached hitters and infielders for the Gauchos, helping UCSB to a 13-2 mark during the shortened 15-game season on the strength of 37 extra-base hits and ten home runs.

Eric Hutting begins his first season as the Cougars Assistant Coach and will work with the catchers while assisting with the pitchers and hitters after working the past two seasons with Choate at Loyola Marymount as an assistant coach, working with the catchers and assisting with the LMU hitters. Hutting helped Loyola Marymount to a 2023 West Coast Conference title last season while the Lions captured the West Coast Conference Pitcher of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Choate was named WCC Coach of the Year. LMU claimed its first outright regular season title in 25 years with a 29-24 mark including an impressive 21-6 record in conference play while a pair of Lions earned All-America honors with five players receiving All-WCC honors.

Brandon Vial begins his first season as the Cougars Director of Player Development after working the past two seasons as an assistant coach at Lewis-Clark State College, helping coach the pitchers and catchers as the Warriors reached the NAIA National Championship game in 2022 and 2023. The 2022 LC pitching staff finished the season second in the NAIA with a 3.21 ERA. In the summer of 2022, Vial was the head coach of the Walla Walla Sweets in the West Coast Summer League while in the 2021 summer, Vial was named the Northwoods League Coach of the Year after leading the St. Cloud Rox pitching staff to a record-setting summer.

Austin Ames begins his first season as the Director of Baseball Operations after working the 2023 summer as an operations intern at Team USA in North Carolina and as an operations intern for Major League Baseball at the Jackie Robinson Training Complex in Vero Beach, Florida. Prior to working with MLB, Ames was a ticket sales associate for the St. Louis Cardinals during the 2022 season and worked in a number of roles for the Southeast Missouri State Athletic Department (2020-22).

#### JOHN OLERUD NAMED PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE CENTURY

The Pac-12 Conference inducted Coug legend John Olerud into the Pac-12 Hall of Honor in 2019. Olerud was named the Pac-12 Conference's Baseball Player of the Century in 2016. During his three seasons in a Cougar uniform, Olerud (1987-89) had one of the finest careers of any Cougar studentathlete, in any sport, in Washington State history, rewriting the WSU record books and becoming the only Cougar baseball athlete ever to be named College Athlete of the Year. In 1988, Olerud became the only player in NCAA history to win 15 games on the mound and hit 20 home runs in the same season, going 15-0 with 23 home runs that year. Olerud went 26-4 overall with a 3.17 ERA over 241.1 innings during his three seasons, hitting .434. He set two Pac-10 records and 10 Pac-10 North marks, highlighted by his sophomore season when he was named Athlete of the Year by Baseball America. In January prior to his junior year at WSU, Olerud suffered a subarachnoid hemorrhage, a type of brain seizure. He missed the first 28 games of the spring season, but returned to hit .359 for WSU over the final 27 games. Prior to his senior season, Olerud signed a contract with Toronto and went directly to the Major Leagues. In 1993, he became the first Blue Jay to win a batting title, hitting .363. Olerud played for Toronto, the New York Mets and Yankees, Seattle and Boston during his 17-year career, winning back-to-back World Series titles with Toronto in 1992 and 1993. In 2001 he joined his father, John Sr., in the WSU Athletics Hall of Fame, and is a member of the College Baseball, State of Washington and Inland Northwest Sports Halls of Fame. The John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, given annually by the College Baseball Hall of Fame, was named in his honor and in 2016, he was named the Pac-12 Conference Player of the Century.





Washington State University named Nathan Choate as the 18th head baseball coach in program history, Director of Athletics Patrick Chun announced June 23.

Choate arrived at WSU after leading Loyola Marymount to a West Coast Conference title this past season while guiding the Lions to new heights in his four seasons leading the program. Choate was named the 2023 WCC Coach of the Year after leading LMU to their first outright regular season title in 25 years with a 29-24 mark including an impressive 21-6 record in conference play, four games ahead of second-place Portland, and swept four WCC series. Choate coached a pair of Lions to All-America honors while five players earned All-WCC honors in addition to the WCC Pitcher of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year.

"WSU Baseball is our oldest and most storied program. Coach Nathan Choate is the exact fit we need to lead us into the next chapter of WSU Baseball," Chun said. "What he accomplished at LMU speaks for itself. His values and principles are aligned with WSU. We are excited to welcome Nathan, Lori and the Choate Family to Washington State University."

Choate's 2023 LMU club tallied road wins at Vanderbilt and Oklahoma State, claimed six WCC Pitcher of the Week honors, one WCC Player of the Week and the pitching staff finished their season ranked sixth nationally in walks per nine innings and 26th nationally in walk to strikeout ratio. Choate coached three all-conference pitchers in 2023 led by ace Diego Barrera who earned All-America honors after going 8-2 with 93 strikeouts and a 2.17 ERA while Khadim Diaw earned Freshman All-America honors after hitting .314 with eight home runs, 11 doubles, two triples, 33 RBI, 47 runs scored and 66 hits. In the classroom, the Lions closed the 2023 season with a 3.18 team GPA including 24 players with a 3.0 or higher.

Throughout his coaching career, Choate has accumulated 25 players drafted in the MLB Draft, seven of which have been selected in the top-10 rounds, 10 All-Americans, two College World Series appearances, three Team USA pitchers, four Freshman All-Americans, two Big West Freshman Pitchers of the Year, two WCC Pitchers of the Year and nine All-Conference Pitchers. In the 2017 season with San Diego his team finished sixth in the country in strikeouts and his 2019 Lion pitching staff to the 14th best ERA in the nation.

"My family and I couldn't be more excited to join All-WCC selections with Codie Paiva being named WCC the Washington State University family. Thank you to President Schulz, Pat Chun and Mitch Straub for the opportunity to lead the baseball program," Choate said. We look forward to earning the respect of past, current, and future Cougs, as well as the Pullman Community. Go Cougs!"

The 2021 season saw the Lions open up with 14 straight games against the Pac-12, winning two weekend series including a three-game sweep of Utah and a road series win at Washington. In addition to his success against the Pac-12, the Lions won six of the nine weekend series versus the WCC. On the offensive end, LMU led the conference in triples with 15 and were among the WCC leaders in stolen bases and stolen bases per game. On the mound, Choate produced one of the most lethal end of game pitchers in Holden Christian who was named to the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings NCAA Division I West All-Region Second Team, finishing the The Lions pitching staff had 342 strikeouts and four members posted an ERA of 3.43 or below.

In 2020, his first season at the helm of the Loyola Marymount Lions, Choate went 8-8 winning three of his first four weekend series including a sweep of San Jose State. Under Choate's direction the Lions pitching staff posted an ERA of 4.07 had a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.61, which ranked third in the WCC.

Offensively, LMU led the WCC and ranked 25th nationally in stolen bases with 32 and set the school record for steals in a game with eight at UC Davis on March 1, 2020. Choate's aggressiveness on the bases was aided by the Lions discipline at the plate resulting in 84 free passes which also led the conference.

Choate's first win came in his first game leading LMU when they beat the Washington Huskies 7-1. In 2020 he also took part in the second-longest game in NCAA history in both time and length with a 24 inning, six hour and thirty minute contest on Feb. 28 - 29 at UC Davis. In the game I MU set the school record for at-bats with 79 and Trevin Esquerra tied the NCAA record and set the Chance, Kyla and Kacey. Lions record for at-bats with 11.

In 2019 the Lions finished with a 34-25 overall mark, won their first five series and secured a berth into the WCC Championship Tournament where they beat WCC regular season champions BYU before posting backto-back victories over Saint Mary's to clinch their first WCC Championship Tournament Title. The Lions beat No. 24 Baylor and No. 11 UCLA in the NCAA Tournament before falling to the Bruins in the deciding game of the Los Angeles Regional. The Lions were able to nab six

Pitcher of the Year.

Prior to his hiring in 2019, Choate spent the previous two years as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at WCC-rival San Diego. While with the Toreros, Choate helped guide USD to a combined 58-50-1 record. In his first season with San Diego in 2017, Choate's staff struck out 9.7 batters per nine innings to record the sixth-best rate in the nation and lead the WCC. Torero ace, Nick Sprengel, went 9-1 to tie a program record for win percentage and was named to the All-WCC First team. Chris Murphy was named to the Freshmen All-American team after striking out 11.61 batters per nine innings - the fifth-best rate in a single-season in program history. In his two seasons, five Torero pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including right-hander Paul Richan by the Chicago Cubs in the second round of the 2018 June Draft.

Before coming to USD, Choate had been the pitching year with three wins, four saves, and an ERA of 0.97. coach and recruiting coordinator at Grand Canyon University for five years. While at GCU, he helped lead the 'Lopes to a DII World Series appearance and a WAC Championship while the school was transitioning to DI. Considered one of the top recruiters in the nation, Choate also spearheaded a top-35 ranked recruiting class in 2015.

> Prior to his time at Grand Canvon, Choate spent four years at UC Riverside, where he served as the Highlanders' pitching coach and recruiting coordinator, helping 11 pitchers get drafted by MLB clubs, including Joe Kelly and Matt Andriese. Before UCR, Choate was the pitching coordinator for UC Irvine, which finished fourth at the 2007 College World Series.

> Choate pitched collegiately at Cal Poly for two seasons, where he was awarded the Jim Newkirk Fireman's Award, given to the team's best relief pitcher, in his junior and senior seasons. He also pitched two seasons at Santa Ana Junior College in 1998 and 1999, helping the Dons to a third-place national finish in 1999.
