= American Athletic Conference Championship in Clearwater, Florida Home games in **bold** played at Eck Stadium, Home of Tyler Field All times are CENTRAL SCENE SETTER: Wichita State prepares for a pair of midweek games at Eck Stadium this week, hosting Oklahoma on Tuesday night and Kansas on Wednesday night. It is the first of three times this season in which the Shockers play two midweek games against two different opponents (April 9-10, April 30-May 1) and the only one of the three in which both games are at home. Wichita State is coming off a three-game sweep of Rice this past week; the Shockers won 7-5, 10-3 and 15-3 in a game that was called after seven innings due to the run rule. WSU has won all six of their weekend series and are tied atop the conference standings with UTSA at 5-1. The Shockers are coming off a 30-25 season in 2023 that included a 13-10 mark in American Athletic Conference play, good for third place in the final conference standings. Wichita State is hunting their first appearance in the NCAA tournament since the 2013 season, a regional bid that was later vacated by the NCAA.

SHOCKER BASEBALL ON THE RADIO AND ESPN PLUS: KFH 97.5 FM/1240 AM will once again serve as the radio home for Wichita State baseball broadcasts in 2024. "The Voice of the Shockers" and Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Famer Mike Kennedy will have the call for both games. Both games will also be streamed live on ESPN+, with former Shocker pitcher (1991-94) and Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Famer Shane Dennis handling play-by-play duties. Live audio, in addition to live statistics, will be available for both games at GoShockers.com/listen and ShockerStats.com.

OKLAHOMA SERIES HISTORY: The Shockers and Sooners have met 37 times, with Oklahoma holding a 21-16 lead in the all-time series. Oklahoma downed Wichita State 5-3 on March 5 in Norman, using a combination of eight pitchers to hold off the Shockers. WSU bested OU in two of three 2023 meetings; on March 28 at Riverfront Stadium in Wichita, Brock Rodden blasted a go-ahead, three-run homer in the bottom of the eighth for an 8-7 WSU victory and on March 14 the Shockers beat the Sooners 6-2, riding five shutout innings from Caden Favors and a late two-run homer from Chuck Ingram to the victory at Eck Stadium. Oklahoma claimed the final meeting of the year on April 11 with an 8-1 win. The two teams have also met once in the College World Series, an 8-4 Oklahoma win in 1992 that eliminated the Shockers.

KANSAS SERIES HISTORY: The Shockers and Jayhawks have met 87 times, with Wichita State holding 51-36 lead in the all-time series. Kansas won both games of the season series a year ago, using four pitchers to hold WSU to five hits in a 4-0 victory on March 8 at Hoglund Ballpark and then earning a 7-5 win at Eck Stadium on April 26. Michael Brooks delivered a go-ahead, two-run single in the top of the tenth inning that proved to be the difference after WSU rallied in the ninth to force extra innings. From 2013-2016, Kansas won seven consecutive games in the series, and recently Wichita State put together a six-game winning streak from 2017-2022.

SCOUTING OKLAHOMA: The Sooners enter Tuesday with a 15-12 record after getting swept in a three-game home series against Lamar. Their 7-2 conference record leads the Big 12, highlighted by series sweeps against UCF and TCU. The Sooners have three players hitting .356 or better, led by second baseman Jackson Nicklaus at .393. Nicklaus also leads the Big 12 with a .518 on-base percentage. On the mound, Oklahoma is pitching to a 4.94 ERA and averages 10.2 strikeouts per nine innings. The Sooners are coming off a 32-28 record in 2023 that ended with a 1-2 showing at the Charlottesville Regional. Seventh year head coach Skip Johnson owns a 205-144 record and helped lead Oklahoma to the College World Series finals in 2022. Former Wichita State head coach Todd Butler is an assistant on Johnson's staff. Former Wichita State pitchers Jace Miner and Austin Henry transferred to Oklahoma after the 2023 season.

SCOUTING KANSAS: The Jayhawks check in to play on Wednesday at 15-10 overall and 7-5 in the Big 12 after a road sweep at BYU last week. Kansas deploys one of the nation's best weekend rotations, as the trio of Reese Dutton, Dominic Voegele and Patrick Steitz has combined for an 11-4 record all with ERAs at 2.30 or better. Closer Hunter Cranton has not allowed an earned run in 11.2 innings while striking out 17. Catcher Jake English paces the Jayhawk attack offensively, leading the team with a .346 average and eight home runs. Head coach Dan Fitzgerald is in his second season with the Jayhawks and previously spent nine seasons as an assistant at Dallas Baptist, a former Missouri Valley Conference foe. Former Wichita State volunteer assistant coach Jon Coyne is a member of Fitzgerald's staff.

NO RUNNING: The three-game series between Rice and Wichita featured just two combined stolen base attempts and only one that would qualify as a traditional steal attempt; Rice's Eric Correa was thrown out at second base in Saturday's series finale while WSU's Jordan Rogers successfully swiped second on Friday. Rogers's steal occurred when he was caught between bases before beating the throw to second.

POWER OF THE PLUNK: Wichita State tied a program record for hit by pitches twice in the Rice series, earning six HBPs on both Thursday and Saturday. The Shockers lead the conference and rank sixth nationally with 68 hit by pitches; Jordan Rogers (14), Mauricio Millan (12) and Derek Williams (11) rank 1-2-3 on the conference leaderboard.

SHOCKERS IN THE RPI: Wichita State enters the game on Tuesday ranked 78 in the latest edition of the Warren Nolan RPI (Rating Percentage Index). The Shockers have the second-best RPI in the American Athletic Conference, trailing only East Carolina at 13. This week's opponents, Oklahoma and Kansas, are ranked 29 and 60, respectively.

STAYING OFF THE BARREL: The Shockers enter play on Tuesday allowing only 7.20 hits per nine innings, the eighth-best mark in the nation. Wichita State pitchers are holding opponents to a .217 batting average and have held the opposition to six or fewer hits in 13 of 27 games.

BUSY MEN: Wichita State relievers Caleb Anderson and Hunter Holmes have worn out a path from the bullpen to the mound this season, logging 16 and 15 appearances respectively to rank second and 13th nationally.

PINCH-HIT POP: Coming into the 2024 season, WSU had not had a pinch-hit home run since Mason O'Brien came off the bench and homered against South Florida on May 11, 2018. Junior Josh Livingston accomplished the feat twice in the first 11 games of 2024, cranking a three-run shot against lowa on February 25 and replicating the achievement with a solo blast against Oklahoma on March 5.

GREENER PASTURES: Brian Green was named the fifth head coach in the modern era of Wichita State baseball on June 5, 2023, replacing interim head coach Loren Hibbs. Green comes to Wichita State after four seasons at the helm of Washington State, where he guided the Cougars to four straight seasons above .500, the first such stretch of success for the Cougars since 2006-10. Green went 91-79 overall in Pullman, including a 29-win season in 2023 that matched the most wins for Washington State since 2010. Prior to his tenure with Wazzu, Green revitalized the program at his alma mater New Mexico State, taking the Aggies from 11 wins in 2015 to 40 in 2018. In 10 total seasons as a head coach, Green owns a career record of 267-210-1, good for a .560 winning percentage.

ROSTER REVAMP: It is a new-look Wichita State roster in 2024, as only 11 players return from the 2023 club. AAC Player of the Year Brock Rodden was drafted in the 5th Round by the Seattle Mariners, senior Sawyre Thornhill exhausted his eligibility, and the remaining 23 players transferred. 17 of those 23 ended up at another Division I institution. Catcher Mauricio Millan (54 starts), outfielder Seth Stroh (32 starts) and utilitymen Jordan Rogers (10 starts) and Will Stark (10 starts in 2022) lead the returners in experience, while Caden Favors (21 appearances) and Matt Wilkinson (18 appearances) are the senior members of the pitching staff.

JUCO BANDITS: Following the 25 departures from the 2023 club, head coach Brian Green turned to the junior college ranks to form his first roster with the Shockers. Wichita State has 14 newcomers who played at the NJCAA level a year ago: pitchers Mason Munz, Gavin Oswald, Caleb Anderson, Daniel Zang, Hunter Holmes, Peyton Walters and Jack Mount (7) and position players Brayden Luikart, Dayvin Johnson, Logan Kreske, Ryan Callahan, Derek Williams, Josh Livingston and Sammy Harris (7).

MEET THE STAFF: Green wasted little time finalizing his assistant coaches, announcing the hires just two weeks after joining the Shockers. Veteran pitching coach Anthony Claggett came along from Washington State, recruiting coordinator Clay Overcash was brought on board after six seasons in the same role at Oklahoma, and hitting coach Anthony Miller, who as a player was committed to play for Green at NMSU, rounded out the assistants following four seasons at the junior college level. The Shockers director of baseball operations is Tad Reida, a former Shocker infielder who helped Wichita State to consecutive NCAA tournament appearances in 2004 and 2005.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: With a program record of 2,328 wins, 1,257 losses and nine ties, Wichita State ranks in the top ten of all college baseball programs with a .648 winning percentage. The Shockers have won 20 regular season conference championships and 18 conference tournament championships, earning a trip to Omaha for the College World Series on seven different occasions. Head Coach First Season

A veteran leader with nine seasons of head coaching experience, Brian Green was named the fifth head coach in the modern era of Wichita State baseball on June 7, 2023.

Green comes to Wichita State after four seasons at the helm of Washington State, where he improved the Cougars win total in each of his four campaigns. Inheriting a program that won 11 games in 2019, Green guided Washington State to four straight seasons above .500, the first such stretch of success for the Cougars since 2006-10.

Green went 91-79 overall in his four seasons in Pullman, including a 29-win season in 2023 that matched the most wins for Washington State since 2010.


Prior to his tenure with Wazzu, Green revitalized the program at his alma mater New Mexico State, authoring college baseball's biggest turnaround in 2016. Following an 11-38-1 mark in his first year with the Aggies, Green led New Mexico State to a 34-23 record the following season, a 23-win improvement. He followed up the impressive turnaround with a 35-20 season in 2017, then engineered a historic 2018 campaign. The Aggies finished 40-22 and claimed their first WAC tournament title, advancing to the NCAA Regionals for the first time since 2012. Green went 38-17 in his final season in Las Cruces, posting the best winning percentage for NMSU in a decade.

In nine total seasons as a head coach, Green owns a career record of 249-201-1, good for a .553 winning percentage. Green has appeared in seven NCAA Regionals as a head coach or assistant coach at the Division I level.

Prior to his two head coaching stints, Green has served as an assistant coach at Kentucky [2009-14] and UCLA [2005-08], in addition to previous coaching roles at Hawaii, Oregon State, San Diego, Chapman University, Cal Poly-Pomona, and Riverside City College.

Green, a native of Temecula, Calif., graduated from New Mexico State with a degree in business management in 1995 and earned his master's degree in education from National University in 1997. He played collegiately at Riverside City College, Chapman University, and New Mexico State.

Green is married to the former Becki Francis and they have two daughters, Emily and Zoe.

Pitching Coach First Season

Claggett is in his first season at Wichita State after joining the Shockers on June 20, 2023. He has worked alongside head coach Brian Green as Green's pitching coach for each of the last six seasons, four at Washington State and two at New Mexico State.

While with the Cougars, Claggett oversaw a staff that established a new program record for strikeouts in each of the last two seasons, capped off by 518 punchouts in 2023. Washington State ranked 17th nationally with 10.3 strikeouts per nine innings and 15th nationally with a 2.76:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Cougar pitchers issued 3.72 walks per nine innings, the 35th-best rate in the country. Over his three full seasons in Pullman, Claggett's pitching staffs recorded more strikeouts and fewer walks each season.

Claggett joined the Washington State program in 2020, inheriting a pitching staff coming off a 7.20 ERA the year prior. In the COVID-shortened 2020 campaign he helped slice more than three full runs off the team ERA to 3.94, kick-starting a run of four straight seasons above .500, the first such stretch of success for the Cougars since 2006-10.

In two seasons at New Mexico State, Claggett helped the Aggies to an NCAA regional appearance in 2018 behind a pitching staff that featured a trio of all-conference arms and recorded a school-record 537 strikeouts. Left-hander Jonathan Groff was named WAC Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first Aggies hurler in program history to claim conference Pitcher of the Year honors. Righty Kyle Bradish became the highest-drafted pitcher in program history when he was selected in the 4th round of the

MLB draft by the Baltimore Orioles, where he is currently a member of their starting rotation.

Prior to New Mexico State, Claggett spent time on the coaching staffs at San Jose State, Riverside Community College and College of the Desert, plus one season in professional baseball with the independent New Jersey Jackals.

As a player, Claggett made three appearances at the major league level in 2009 with the New York Yankees and Pittsburgh Pirates as part of an 11-year professional career. He was an 11th round draft pick by the Detroit Tigers out of UC Riverside, where he was both a pitcher and infielder.

Catching Coach/Recruiting Coordinator First Season

Overcash is in his first season at Wichita State after joining the Shockers on June 20, 2023. He joins the Shockers after six seasons in the same role at Oklahoma, where he helped the Sooners to the College World Series finals in 2022 and two other NCAA tournament appearances in 2018 and 2023.

During his time in Oklahoma, Overcash and the Sooners compiled a .591 winning percentage [189-131], highlighted by eight postseason victories. Overcash was largely responsible for the recruitment and development of 31 MLB draft picks since 2018, including 11 Sooners in the 2022 draft alone.

Overcash consistently produced elite recruiting classes while with the Sooners, ranking 13th in the country in 2021 and 22nd the following year according to Perfect Game. In his most recent class this past season, Overcash helped sign 14 players, six of which ranked among the top 25 in their respective states. All 12 of the high school signees ranked in Perfect Game's top 500 players in the country.

That recruiting philosophy paid dividends on the diamond with an offense built around patience and athleticism. In 2023, Oklahoma ranked 11th nationally in walks (350) and 19th nationally in stolen bases (114), following up on top-five marks in both categories a year prior.

Over the course of his time in Norman, Overcash developed a pair of Sooner backstops into fourth round MLB draft picks; Brady Lindsly in 2020 and Jimmy Crooks in 2022. This past season, Oklahoma catcher Easton Carmichael was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman team. Prior to arriving in Norman, Overcash served 18 years as a Midwest area scout for the Chicago White Sox and was involved with the Area Code Games as a part of the Midwest Scout Team. A native of Charlotte, North Carolina, Overcash was also a co-founder of The Sandlot Sox Organization, a Tulsa-based youth baseball organization that produced 64 MLB draft picks from 2005 until its closing in 2017.

Overcash played collegiately at Middle Georgia Junior College and USC Upstate, earning All-District honors in 1990. He began his coaching career with stints as an assistant at UNC Asheville and Armstrong State, later moving to Tulsa where Overcash coached high school baseball before joining the White Sox.

Hitting/Outfield Coach First Season

Miller is in his first season at Wichita State after joining the Shockers on June 20, 2023. He comes to Wichita after four seasons as an assistant coach at the NJCAA level, most recently in his second stint at Johnson County Community College.

This past season, Miller and the Cavaliers reached the NJCAA D1 World Series for the third time in program history and the first time since 2014. JCCC went 56-10, including a 30-3 mark in Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference play. 14 Cavaliers were named to the All-KJCCC East Division Team, including conference Pitcher of the Year Luc Fladda and Co-Freshman of the Year Dagen Brewer.

Johnson County finished second in the country with a .364 team batting average, fourth with a .466 on-base percentage, and sixth with 597 runs scored. As a team, the Cavaliers drew nearly as many walks [336] as they had strikeouts [346]. The Cavaliers team fielding percentage of .976 was the second-best mark in NICAA Division 1.

Miller returned to JCCC after two seasons a volunteer coach at McLennan Community College in Waco, Texas under current Baylor head coach Mitch Thompson. Miller helped the Highlanders to consecutive NJCAA World Series appearances, highlighted by a national championship in 2021. During his time in Waco, Miller and McLennan compiled a 97-29 overall record [.770 winning percentage], four NJCAA All-Americans and three MLB draft picks.

A former All-American as a player at JCCC, Miller returned to his alma mater to begin his coaching career in 2020.

The Cavaliers were 20-3 with a top-10 national ranking before the season was canceled due to COVID-19.

All told in four seasons as an assistant, Miller's teams have combined for a record of 173-42, good for a winning percentage of .805.

As a player with the Cavaliers, Miller was a Second Team NJCAA All-American as a sophomore in 2015, hitting .443 with a school-record 26 home runs. He was drafted by Cleveland in the 18th round, where he played five seasons in their minor league system. Miller ultimately reached Double-A in 2019, and finished his professional playing career with 25 home runs and 117 RBI in 310 career games.


