ATHLETE CHECK-IN

Athletes can check in a for running events any time at the clerks tent. Athletes must report for their event 20 minutes prior to the scheduled time.

Check in for field events will be done at the event site.

TEAM CAMPS

The soccer field east of the press box will serve as the team camp and primary warm up area.

Rock Chalk Park will open general team camp / general warm up area to competitors and coaches on Saturday, April 27 at 7:30 a.m. Only athletes will be permitted inside the competition areas.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry into the Rock Chalk Classic, hosted by the University of Kansas, is invitation only. Teams invited to compete will be given access to enter online at www.directathletics.com. All entry fees must be paid through Direct Athletics.

Entry Deadline – All entries are due online at: directathletics.com. by 6:00 p.m. (CST) on Wednesday, April 24, 2024.

Entry Fee: \$500 / team. \$25.00 / unattached individual.

TEAM PACKETS

Packet pickup will be located at Rock Chalk Park in the lower level. Coaches may enter through the doorway located on the Southeastern corner of the lower level. Signs will be posted. Packets will be available beginning Saturday, April 27 at 7:30 a.m.

ATHLETIC TRAINERS

The University of Kansas will provide certified trainers and regular supplies used in their normal activities. A training area has been designated on the west side behind the west stands. Schools are welcome to bring their own trainers. Trainers will be allowed on the infield for emergency purposes only.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms will be located outside the competition area for athletes and coaches. Restrooms will be placed at the Southwest corner, Northwest side near warm-up straightaways. There will be additional restrooms on the west end of the Soccer/warm up area.

INFIELD POLICY

The infield must remain clear at all times. Only competing athletes will be permitted on the infield immediately before and after their races, near the start and finish areas. Coaches, non-competing athletes, and video staff will not be permitted on the infield. Stretching areas are available behind the seating areas. For liability reasons involving the throws cage, we must keep the infield clear.

FIELD EVENTS

Weigh-in for the throwing events will take place 90 minutes prior to the start of the event, behind the west stands. All field events will advance the top nine (9) marks to the finals.

WARM UPS

Warm up areas are the following:

Soccer field – east of the press box

Sprint lanes – behind the west stands

There are running trails, parking lots, and the streets around Rock Chalk Park
