- » Senior Anthony Tulimero began his career at Kansas starting 67 of 71 games while hitting .252 over two seasons wwith the Jayhawks (2020-21).
- » This is the first three game series between Houston and Kansas.

NEWS AND NOTES

- » Freshman Ace Reese hit a go-ahead three-run home run in the sixth inning Tuesday night in Houston's come from behind win over Nicholls. Three three RBI performance marked a career-high for the freshman.
- » Second baseman Harold Coll hit the team's third grand slam of the season, tying Saturday's game against UCF at 4-4 in the 6th inning.
- » Senior Carv Arbolida has hit multiple home runs in three different games. this season (vs Texas, 4/12; 2x vs UT Arlington, 4/26 & 4/28).
- » Arbolida is on a seven-game hitting streak in which he is hitting .462 with 12 hits, five home runs 11 RBI and seven runs scored.
- » The Cougars scored five or more runs in 13 games in April and hit multipe home runs in 12 games during April.
- » Left fielder Ace Reese recorded his first-career three-hit game at Texas A&M with two opposite field hits including an opposite field home run. Reese is now third among Big 12 Conference freshmen in homers (six).
- » Coll's 3.32 WAR (wins above replacement) ranks sixth in the Big 12 and eighth among second basemen nationally. Coll's 3.32 WAR is second among Big 12 second basemen.
- » The Cougars have scored 20+ runs in two games this year after beating Southern 25-0 on Wednesday. It marks the first time Houston has scored 20+ in multiple games in the same season.
- Houston hit more home runs in the month of April (37) than it did in both February and March combined (26). Houston averaged 2.18 home runs per game across 17 games in April compared to 0.96 in February and March, combined, across 16 games.
- » Three different Cougars have hit 10+ home runs in 2024, marking the third-straight year a trio of Cougars have hit 10+ homers in the same season.
- » Houston is on pace to hit more home runs then its opponents for the first time in a full season since 2019. The Cougars pitchers have given up just 36 home runs in 2024 while hitting 64 thus far.
- » The Cougars pitching staff is on pace for the second-most strikeouts in a single season with 576 thanks to their 10.6 strikeouts per nine innings pace. The school record 605 was set in 2003 over 598.1 innings (9.1 strikeouts per nine) in which Houston played a school record 67 games.
- » Freshman Anthony Avalos recorded his first-career hit on a pinch-hit two-run home run at #1 Texas A&M on Tuesday.
- » Third baseman Anthoy Tulimero is the first Cougar to eclipse 100 RBI in their Houston career since Ryan Hernandez (107) did so from 2020-22. Tulimero has 139 career RBI from his time at Houston and Kansas.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Rallied down 3-0 to take a 4-3 lead thanks to a pair of home runs from freshmen Conner Bennett and Ace Reese.
- » A bases loaded walk-off single by senior Cary Arbolida scored the winning run.

ALL-JUSTIN MURRAY

- » Senior Justin Murray played just about everywhere but catcher in 2023. The senior played in 57 of the team's 59 games and appeared 25 times out of the bullpen, mostly after playing a corner infield position or designated hitter.
- » Murray led the team in average (.379) and slugging (.598) and finished second on the team in home runs (11). On the mound, Murray paced the team with 10 saves, good for 25th nationally, and posted 49 strikeouts over 41.0 innings.
- » The Dartmouth transfer earned All-America honors and All-Region honors after being named American Athletic Conference Newcomer Position Player of the Year and an All-Conference First-Team selection.

TOP 50 RECRUITING CLASS...AGAIN

- » According to Perfect Game, the Cougars compiled the 46th best recruiting class in the country in 2023 and are currently ranked 45th nationally for 2024 with the #25 prospect in the country, Braylon Payne signing his National Letter of Intent in November.
- » The 2023 class of freshmen includes **10** freshmen with **nine** ranked in the top 500 nationally by Perfect Game which ranks fourth in the Big 12 by PerfectGame.

- » Houston's active leader in games played, Anthony Tulimero (118) returns for the Cougars in 2024 after playing 58 of 59 games in 2023 and 60 of 61 games in 2022.
- » The catcher leads Houston's active roster in hits (138), triples (3), home runs (15) and RBI (82).

MAINE TO HOUSTON PIPELINE

- » Two Houston shortstops played collegiate baseball at Maine. One is a World Series Champion and the other is a Houston Cougar in 2024.

NO DAYS OFF (ACTUALLY A FEW) IN 2024

- » Not only will Houston face a tougher conference schedule in the Big 12, the Cougars will face a tough non-conference schedule with nine total teams on its 2024 slate that made the 2023 NCAA Tournament (five non-conference opponents, four Big 12 opponents).
- » In fact, of the nine teams that made the 2024 tournament, seven of the teams won at least one game in their respective regional with two advancing out of a regional in which they did not host to a super regional.
- » TCU is the first team that Houston has faced multiple times in a season that is coming off a College World Series run in the previous season since 2018 when it played at Cal State Fullerton for a three game series after the Titans made the 2017 College World Series.
- » Houston faced 2022 College World Series participant Texas A&M at home for a single-game midweek matchup in 2023.

HOUSTON // 2024 GAME NOTES

NEW LOOK BIG 12

- » For the first time since the 2011 season, the Big 12 will have more than nine baseball teams in the league with the addition of Houston, BYU, Cincinnati, and UCF this year.

» Head Coach Todd Whitting added Sean Kenny, Matt Reida and Cougar legend Woody Williams and Andy Davis to his 2024 staff, all coming from the Power 5 ranks.



NEW COACHES KENNY & REIDA

- » With 27 years of coaching experience, Kenny brings a wealth of knowledge to the Houston Baseball program. Kenny has spent the last 14 seasons with Power 5 programs and tutored 45 pitchers selected in the MLB Draft. A former New York Mets draft pick, Kenny spent the previous seven seasons as the pitching coach at the University of Georgia.
- » A native of Ann Arbor, Mich., Kenny followed head coach Erik Bakich to the University of Michigan after three seasons at the University of Maryland. With the Wolverines, Kenny tutored 10 pitchers selected in the MLB Draft while his staff consistently ranked at the top of the Big Ten Conference in multiple categories, helping the program to two NCAA postseason appearances.
- » Reida played a vital role in Alabama's success and his expertise in player evaluation, skill development, and strategic planning contributed significantly to the team's achievements on and off the field.
- » The Crimson Tide reached the 2023 NCAA Super Regionals after hosting and sweeping the NCAA Tuscaloosa Regional. During the 2022 season, the Tide's earned a series sweep at Ole Miss, securing three wins over the eventual national champions while also posting series wins over SEC Western Division Champion Texas A&M and then-No. 5 Arkansas. After the season, four players were selected in the 2022 MLB Draft.

COUGAR LEGEND RETURNS

- » Williams, a Cougar for two seasons before playing 20 years professionally including 15 at the MLB level, joins his alma mater after leading Texas' pitching staff to the 10th-best ERA in the nation and matched Oklahoma State with a Big 12 Conference-best four pitchers selected in the 2023 MLB Draft.
- » Prior to his time at Texas, Williams spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at San Jacinto College, helping lead the Gators to the Junior College World Series five times. Prior to joining San Jac, Williams coached three years at Fort Bend Christian Academy and spent two seasons with the Houston Heat.

LEANING ON ANALYTICS

- » For the first time in program history, the Cougars have added an in-depth analytics department led by Andy Davis.
- » Davis spent three seasons at Georgia where he helped create the analytics department in Athens.
- » The former student manager assisted in the pitching development of 12 MLB draft picks during his time, including four pitchers taken in the first five rounds.

PAIR TABBED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA

Justin Murray and Jake Rainess, were named National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Preseason All-Americans on February 6.

Murray, a utility player who began his career at Dartmouth, was named to the Second Team as a utility player after he racked up a team-high 10 saves out of the bullpen in 2023 for the Cougars while leading the American Athletic Conference in average (.379) and hitting posting double digit home run (11) and double (11) numbers. Murray's 5-0 record out of the bullpen led the team in winning percentage on his way to a 3.07 ERA and All-America Third Team honors a year ago. The right-hander was named a Top 50 first baseman by D1Baseball on Jan. 31 as the 22nd ranked first baseman.

Rainess, a senior transfer from Maine, was named to the Third Team as a shortstop after he helped lean the Black Bears to the NCAA Tournament in 2023 while hitting .321 with 16 home runs, 14 doubles and 38 stolen bases. The shortstop's 38 stolen bases in 2023 lead all NCWBA Preseason All-Americans. Rainess was named the 13th best shortstop in the country by D1Baseball on Monday and the fourth best in the Big 12 Conference.

In total, there were 45 different schools and 16 DI conferences represented on the 2024 DI All-America teams, which also have individuals honored from 22 teams ranked in various preseason polls. Houston is one of 19 schools to have at least two athletes on the All-America list and one of four Big 12 schools with multiple honorees.
